Gods of the Forge of Northern Europe

This month, we continue our discovery of Gods of the forge by moving into northern Europe. I researched the pantheons of Gaullish, Anglo-Saxon, Celtic, Slavic, Norse, Germanic, and Finnish cultures looking for the gods of the forge or crafts. The gods and goddesses presented in this article are Anglo-Saxon Wayland, Germanic Volund, Celtic Goibhnui, Slavic Svarog, Finnish Ilmarinen, Celtic Lugh, Gaullish Belisama and Celtic Brigid. These gods and goddesses have many things in common as they are often the same god or goddess with a different name. Their stories are often very similar and depending on how you pronounce the names, sound very similar for some.

First off, we have Wayland our Volund which are really the same god but with an anglo-saxon spelling for Wayland and a Germanic spelling for Volund. Legend says that Wayland was a lord of the elves imprisoned and lamed by the king so that he could not escape and stay as his personal smith. He eventually gets revenge by decapitating the kings two sons and making drinking cups out of their skulls that he gives to their father, raping the king's daughter when she brings him a ring to repair and escaping his prison using wings that he created himself. (Sounds very familiar to the story of Daedalus escaping King Minos' labyrinth from last month's article) As a god of the pantheon he was considered God of the forge. He allegedly forged the sword Excalibur for King Arthur himself.

The Irish called their god of the forge Goibhnui and as often with Irish tradition he was part of a triple god with Goibhnui being the divine smith, the divine carpenter Luchtainé and the divine bronze-worker Credné. Goibhnui literally means smith. Goibhnui is known to have rendered the people of the goddess Danu immortal with his mead and his weapons. The people were known as the Tuatha de Danaan. They did not die and their weapons were unbreakable.

Lugh was also of Irish/Celtic myth and was considered Goibhnui's nephew by many but what is curious is one tale explains that Lugh's grandfather Balor (an enemy of the Tuatha de Danaan) was told he would be murdered by one of his grandsons. He imprisoned his only daughter so that she would not have a family, but she was seduced by one of the Tuatha de Danaan and gave birth to triplets (yes triplets just like the triple gods). Balor tried to drown the triplets but one of them survived and was raised by a blacksmith. Later he fought alongside the Tuatha de Danaan in battle and killed Balor his grandfather. Although some portray him as part Tuatha de Danaan and a craftsman, it makes you wonder if he wasn't a personification of Goibhnui. Lugh was the patron god of the crafts, creativity and even fertility. Even to this day many Wiccans still call upon him when in need of inspiration and also for his festival Lughnasadh.

Continuing with the Irish/Celtic traditions we come to Brigid who was a triple goddess just as Goibhnui is a triple god. Her name means fiery power or "exalted one" and she was a goddess of the Tuatha de Danaan. She is a triple goddess for her triple functions which are:

- 1. Protector of poets, divination arts and magic
- 2. Patron of medicine and healing arts as well as childbirth and motherhood
- 3. Patron of artisans including smiths

She is a fire goddess associated with the sun and the solar wheel represented by Brigid's cross. Because of her association with fire, she was often considered the goddess of the hearth and called upon to protect homes and for cooking magic.

Belisama is the Gaullish equivalent of Brigid who was also the goddess of light and fire, married to the sun god. She was patron of fire, crafts and wisdom, much like Brigid. Her association with fire made her goddess of smiths who forged metal in fire. She was often depicted with a serpent like Brigid representing fertility. Both Brigid and Belisama were considered equivalent to the Roman Goddess Athena or Minerva.

Now we will head over to Finland where the god Ilmarinen was worshipped as a creator and a weather god. He built the "Sampo", a world pillar that supports the sky and acts as a mill that grounds gold, grain and salt. He was said to use his own knee as his anvil and to create tools from his clothing. Ilmarinen forged the sky and the earth and was said to control the winds. He was essentially the creator god for the Finns.

Last for this month's edition is the Slavic god of the forge Svarog who was considered the creator and master of all the other gods. He is associated with the sky, fire and forging and is said to have coined the sun. He is the equivalent of the Greek Hephaestus. According to myth, Svarog created this world through his dreams and it is the gods of this realm like Perun, Slavic king of the gods that actually physically created what Svarog willed them to create on the physical plane.

There is much more information on each of these gods of the forge but it would be two much to fit into an article. Please feel free to do further research on any that you are curious about. Some of the websites I used for research are listed here.

Next month we will travel to Asia to discover more gods of the forge.

Ostara Recipe for the Northern Hemisphere

Egg tortilla pie found at https://awesomeon20.com adapted from At My Table by Nigella Lawson

INGREDIENTS

- 2 tablespoons garlic-infused olive oil or plain olive oil
- 2 large flour tortillas
- 2-4 slices of ham
- 2 eggs
- Pinch of salt, preferably sea salt flakes
- 75 grams grated cheddar
- Hot sauce to taste



DIRECTIONS

Preheat your oven to 200 C (400 F) Add about a teaspoon of your oil to a round pie pan or cast-iron skillet that's just a bit smaller than your tortillas. Use a pastry brush or even your fingers to grease the base and sides of the pan. Add your first tortilla to the pan.

Add your ham on top of the tortilla. Next, crack in your two eggs on opposite sides of the pan. Sprinkle the eggs with a bit of salt. Finally, scatter about a third of your cheese over the eggs and ham.

Carefully add your second tortilla on top of your filling, being careful not to break your egg yolks. Gently press the edges of the tortilla down to form a bit of a "crust" for your pie. Brush the top of the tortilla with the rest of your oil, making sure you brush the oil all the way around the edges. This will make sure the edges are nice and crispy.

Scatter the remaining cheese over the top, then shake on as much of your favorite hot sauce as you like. Bake this in the oven for 12-15 minutes depending on how well done you want your eggs. For a jammy or even runny egg yolk, take it out of the oven earlier. Cut in half and serve hot.

Mabon Recipe for the Southern Hemisphere

INGREDIENTS

- 2 medium baking potatoes
- 1 tablespoon oil
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 4 slices deli ham
- ½ cup shredded cheddar cheese
- ¼ cup sour cream
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh chives
- ¼ teaspoon cayenne pepper
- Salt and pepper, to taste



DIRECTIONS

Scrub your potatoes and pat them dry. Poke the potatoes several times with a fork. Rub the potatoes with olive oil and salt. Bake in the oven at 350 F (175 C) for at least an hour.

Pierce the potatoes with a sharp knife to check if they're soft all the way through. If not, pop them back in the oven to cook a little more.

Allow the potatoes to cool slightly, then slice them in half lengthwise. Use a spoon to carefully scoop out the soft flesh of the potato without destroying the structural integrity of the potato skin.

Turn on your broiler to preheat.

Put your potato flesh into a mixing bowl with the remaining ingredients. You can hold back a bit of the cheese to be scattered on top at the end if you like. Stir everything together and then carefully scoop the mixture back into your four potato skin shells.

Carefully transfer your filled potatoes to a foil lined baking sheet. Cook potatoes under the broiler for about 10 minutes or until melty and ever so lightly browned.

Allow your potatoes to cool for about five minutes before digging in.

This month, we are going to talk with **Firefay**, or as she really is named: **Amanda Laloue** and was born in USA and lives in Nice, France! She is 39 years old, and she is married to a hyperactive atheist husbandwho was raised Catholic and she has two children. Her son is 15 and has high functioning autism along with ADHD and her daughter is 13 with ADHD and is gifted. She has four Maine Coon cat familiars that does everything with them, including cooking. The youngest one, Sakura, has to get a bite of ham if you're eating it.

Firefay was born in Oklahoma, in the USA and was raised in America. She has a complicated story, being born to a young mother who divorced her Native American father when she was a baby because he was abusing drugs and alcohol. She was afraid for her safety, so she raised her alone. Her mother remarried and divorced several times, so she had several stepfathers that she never really cared for. She moved away from home as soon as she could, at age 18 and went to college. She started studying computer science, but then found an interest in Art history and French. The period from ancient Egypt to the Renaissance were here favorites in Art history and she especially enjoyed architecture.

Once she finished all the undergrad French courses, the professor told her that in order to get a doctorate in French to be able to teach at the college level, she needed to live, at least 2 years in a French speaking country, to become bilingual. The next year, she signed up for classes at the Sorbonne in Paris, France and moved to France at age 20. She met her husband in Paris and ended up moving in with him and never went back to the USA to finish her degree. They later moved to Nice, France and she eventually finished a Bachelor of Science in Accounting online, in order to have a degree just in case. When she was about 22, she got a call from a woman saying she was her older sister and as normal, she didn't know about her since their dad got her mom pregnant in high school. She then told her that they also have a little brother and sister from a later marriage of their dad. Firefay and her sister became very close and she spent time with her, every time she went back home each year. Sadly, she recently committed suicide at age 44 and she misses her very much, but she knows her sister is once again with the Goddess and is no longer suffering.

She had her two children when she was 24 and 26 and was a stay at home mum for several years before joining a school of shiatsu, in Biot, to become a Specialist in Shiatsu. It took four years of study, plus lots of case studies and a professional report to get there. in France, her husband owns a restaurant and is a chef. She work with him part time and the rest of the time she is a Shiatsu, Reiki, and Qi Gong practitioner in a wellness center, in Antibes, France. If you visit the south of France, you can find her wellness center at http://www.kamanao.fr. Today, she is studying for a degree in Metaphysics and is planning to go all the way to a doctorate. She says that: She most likely, will be a lifelong student.

Firefay has an enormous interest in Wicca-related things, everything, actually. She loves anything metaphysical as it is a fascinating subject. For divination-tools, she most likely uses the Tarot, but also enjoys interpreting dreams. When she was 14, she discovered Wicca and started practicing as a solitary witch. She learned everything she could with books and the local Wiccan apothecary. She got together with various Wiccan groups that accepted solitary witches and discovered many different practices, such as Reiki, Shiatsu, Herbal remedies and Magnetism, not to mention many more. Recently, since her kids have gotten older she has missed the social aspect of being part of a group and she searched for Wiccan groups, in France. She didn't find any serious groups in France, but fell upon the Correllian Tradition website and noticed there was a temple in the UK, that did online gatherings and clergy training. She jumped on the occasion and contacted Lady Anna. Who was very kind and sent her everything she needed to join the temple and start her classes. She has been an active member ever since.

Firefay has been with the Correllian Tradition for a year, but she has been Wiccan since age 14. She is a First Degree clergy, working on the Second Degree. She is a member of the Temple of Sedna, the Temple of Isis, the Order of Translators, the Order of Web Weavers, and she also write articles for the Herald. She has finished the Second Degree classes of the Order of Reiki, and has almost completed the Reiki Mentor/Teacher class. She is studying the Temple of Isis clergy class, along with the Correllian Second Degree clergy classes.

We thank **Firefay** for her time answering our question for us. Hoping for continued blessings, for her in the Wicca-path and Correllian Tradition that she is leading.

Crystals and Gemstones Corner

Azurite

This month I chose to present Azurite which is made of copper carbonate hydroxide and has a beautiful blue color that reminds you of a blue sea. This stone is well known for accentuating psychic potential and was, at one time, reserved for priests and priestesses to channel the gods. This stone will take you on journeys that are far from imaginary in different realms but don't forget to use grounding techniques and possibly protection stones as well.

Many connect Azurite with Atlantis, and the stone was used in Egypt by priests, by native Americans to communicate with spirit guides, and in Asia it was believed to open the gates to the spirit realm. The stone was ground to make precious and expensive pigments that could be used in art and for dying clothes for many years.

Azurite can be used to magnify your psychic ability by way of a rubbing stone, but it can also be worn as a bracelet or necklace as a healing stone and to facilitate meditation abilities. The stone is an aura and chakra cleanser and removes blockages in the body that cause physical pain such as headaches and back pains. Azurite is linked to the third eye chakra and not only helps with psychic ability but also helps improve your memory.

Remember as a rule wearing anything circular such as a ring, bracelet or necklace binds the energy of the stone to you, and you absorb that energy. For healing or self-development this is great but if you are searching to magnify the energy or send out your energy to speak with spirit guides or to perform rituals, a simple azurite stone placed on the altar or held in your hand will work best.

If you choose to wear azurite on you take care not to expose it to sunlight as it will fade quickly. Do not expose the stone to heat or it will turn black. This is not a good stone to place in fire or close to one. It is a delicate and soft stone so be sure to take good care of it.

For the Ostara ornament, you will need


- 1 clear ball



Chartered Bodies of the Correllian Tradition

<u>Witan Shrines</u> are the first level of the Temple-Making Process. Witan Shrines are created by Charter of the Tradition and may progress to Full Temple status over the course of several years or remain at Witan Shrine status indefinitely.

<u>Proto-Temples</u> are groups which have progressed beyond the status of Shrines and are on their way to becoming Full Temples but have not yet achieved that status.

<u>Full Temples</u> of the Correllian Tradition have completed the Temple-Making Process and, if headed by a Third Degree, have representation on the Witan Council. A Full Temple can perform all of the functions of a Temple and may in some cases have multiple branches.

<u>Formal Shrines</u> are Shrines that are dedicated to specific activities of a limited nature. Formal Shrines may exist as an aspect of a larger group or may stand alone in their own right.

<u>Personal Shrines</u> are an aspect of an individual Correllian member's personal piety and are not bodies of the Tradition as such. Personal Shrines exist wholly at the discretion of the member, however the Tradition does acknowledge them upon request.
