# Celtic Myths and Legends

## Timeline and Literature

The Irish myths can be set at certain period that coincided with legendary and historical timeline.

The arrival of the Partholarians was said to coincide with that of Noah and the Biblical Flood. Nemed was descendant of Noah's grandson, Magog, son of Japheth. The Fírbolgs and the Tuatha Dé Danann were in turn, descendants of Nemed. The Fírbolgs were enslaved race in Thrace and Greece, before they arrived in Ireland. While the Tuatha Dé Danann learned all sort of magic, druidism, science and arts from the nother.

Japheth's other son, the fictional Fenius Farsaid was said to be the ancestor of the Mil and the Milesians. The Milesians were said to have arrived in Ireland in the 3rd century BC.

While the tale of Cu Chulainn in the *Ulaid Cycle* took place in the 1st century BC, though the death of Conchobar, king of Ulster, coincided with the day Jesus Christ was crucified (c. AD 30).

While the reign of Cormac Mac Airt in the *Fenian Cycle* was said to have set during in the 3rd century AD. Though in the "Colloquy of the Ancients", the heroes Caolite and Oisín survived, during the time of the missionary of St Patrick, in the 5th century AD.

It should be noted that the ancient Gallic and British people left no literature on their myth of their gods and religion, during the Roman Empire. These ancient gods survived on from mainly archaeological evidences, such as inscriptions and their art works (eg. statuettes), and from classical Greek and Roman historians. I have given brief description on some of the Gallic and British deities.

According to a 1st century BC Greek poet, Parthenius, the Celts were descendants of Heracles. As Heracles travelled back to Greece with the cattle of Geryon, Celtine, daughter of Britannus, saw and fell in love with the hero. One day, she hid the cattle, and would not tell Heracles their whereabouts until he made love to her. Heracles slept with her, and Celtine became the mother of Celtus, ancestors of the Celts.

According to another legend about Heracles, written by Diodorus Siculus, the hero met and seduced a nymph named Galata. She was the mother of the Galatians.

No literature survived from Cornwall and Brittany. Breton literature on myth and legend survived only through the writings of French writers.

The majority of the literature Celtic myths, come from Irish and Welsh, and to a lesser extent from the Scots.

Celtic myths, particularly those concerning the Irish cycles (myths) was preserved through oral tradition, probably between the period of Viking settlements in Ireland, from the eighth to the eleventh century AD. They were composed by bards, who would recited the stories, entirely in verses. The Irish sagas weren't written down until the twelfth century AD by monastical scholars.

These tales were recorded in two main manuscripts: the *Book of Leinster* and the *Book of the Dun Cow*. These were collection of hundreds of stories about the Ulaid Cycle and Fenian Cycle. Another manuscript also deserved mentioning, is the *Yellow Book of Lecan* written in the 14th century, containing a large number of stories. The *Colloquy of the Ancients* can be found in Scottish manuscript called the *Book of the Dean of Lismore*, in the 16th century.

More authors added more stories to the Celtic myths, in the 16th and 17th century. The most interesting work was that of James Macpherson (1736-1796), a Scottish poet. He caused controversy, when he claimed the work to be that of Oisín, a warrior-poet of the 3rd century AD. It was discovered that much of the works were really his own invention.

Another author was the Irish writer was William Butler Yeats (1865-1939). Yeats and Macpherson were responsible for renewing people's interests in Celtic myths. They also influenced the Romantic movements in art as well as literature.

The main source for the Welsh myths were the *Mabinogion*. The Mabinogion contains eleven tales. Some of these tales are related or belong to series or cycle.

Dating the individual tales in the Mabinogion, is difficult, because they were probably composed by different writer and at a different time. Culwch and Olwen was one of earliest, continuous tales of King Arthur. The last three Welsh romances paralleled with the works for of the French writer, Chrétien de Troyes who used these materials for his Arthurian romances. (Note that the three Welsh romances does not appear in the Celtic myths, because I preferred the French version in the Arthurian Legends.)

There are even earlier tales of Welsh legends, such as those composed by Taliesin and Aneirin from the 6th century.

Taliesin's poetry were preserved in the *Book of Taliesin* from 13th century. It was more a collection of ecologies, one of them were on King Urien of Rhegedn, mourning for his son's death (Owain).

Aneirin was said to have composed a poem called *Y Gododdin*, but was preserved in a manuscript known as the *Book of Aneirin*, that dated around 1250. The *Y Gododdin* may contained the earliest reference to Arthur.

What I found disappointing about the Irish myths, were the influences of Christianity to the Irish literature. The pagan Celts regarded their gods as their "gods"; whereas the Christian writers had degenerate the deities into little more than fairy people.

Also was the introduction of the legends of Saint Patrick to the Fenian cycle. There are many stories or biographies of other saints mixed with Celtic legends. The lives of these saints were purely propaganda showing that the Church was stronger than other gods. The legends of these saints were mostly to stamped out pagan tales of gods and heroes.

Please note, that a number of tales found in Celtic myths, also contain stories about King Arthur and some of his companions. Except for the "Culhwch and Olwen" and the "Dream of Rhonabwy", all other Welsh tales of Arthur or his companions from the Round Table will be found in the Arthurian branch. The except for those two tales I have mentioned, which don't belonged to the mainstream Arthurian cycle.

# Useful Herbs in Wicca

Herbs that are used in the Wiccan religion have ruling planets and a ruling element, a gender, and usually an overseeing god or goddess. In all the common kitchen herbs, many are used in different Wiccan ways. Common uses are for spell casting, for incense burning, or for baths and oils much like aromatherapy). Using herbs with the Wicca religion is generally viewed as what is called "Green Witchcraft". Wiccans who primarily use herbs are also termed "Green Witches".

Herbs typically have an "essence". It is this essence, combined with the belief of the person, will radiate throughout the herb's use. This article tells of some of the more common herbs, its ruling planets and elements, its gender, how the herb is used, and generally for what purpose.

**Basil (Mars, Fire, Masculine)** Usually used in love or wealth settings, you can use this in a bath to free an old love from your heart or to bring a new love in. Used in purification rituals and makes a good exorcism incense. Basil has the essence of "fidelity".

**Bay Leaves (Sun, Fire, Masculine)** This herb is used in vision and clairvoyance potions for wisdom. It has several different functions such as warding off evil when carried and can be scattered on the floor and swept away for protection or scattered for an exorcism. It is good to add to a cleansing bath or tea. It is said that Delphi priestesses chewed this to induce prophetic visions.

**Camellia (Moon, Water, Feminine)** Camellia flowers are used to show thankfulness or to bring riches into the life. You can place fresh blooms in water to bring prosperity to the altar during a ritual. Chinese medicine men used this for skin condition treatments traditionally.

**Caraway (Mercury, Air, Masculine)** Caraway seeds used in spells will ensure faithfulness and used in cooking will invoke lust for the eater. You carry caraway for protection against harmful spirits or spells.

**Catnip (Venus, Water, Feminine)** Used obviously in animal spells for increasing the bond with the animal and for healing uses. You can use catnip to bring on psychic talent during meditation and as a relaxing tea. Love magic uses catnip by burning the dry leaves.

**Chamomile (Sun, Water, Masculine)** Everyone knows that chamomile is a relaxing herb, especially in teas. This is used in meditation incense, as a sleep enhancer, a prosperity amulet, and to attract wealth. It can clear the head for magic. Using as a bath enhancement can make the herb a love attracter and for bathing children as a protector to evil wishes.

**Cinnamon (Sun, Fire, Masculine)** Cinnamon is known as a male aphrodisiac so it is no wonder that it is used for lust and love spells. Cinnamon is also used for healing, success, psychic abilities and spirituality. Burning the herb as incense or binding in sachets is common. Of course, this can also be mixed in food as a spice for flavor.

**Fennel Seed (Mercury, Fire, Masculine)** Good for purification and protection, fennel seed gives strength and courage. It also will aid in cooking recipes, by freshening breath, helping in weight loss and digestion, and add to flavor. This herb prevents curses and possession.

Feverfew (Venus, Water, Feminine) Used in love spells, it is also a good herb for healing rituals. It will help the immune system and is a good treatment for migraines by reducing light and nausea sensitivity and restricting blood flow. Mostly used in food or sachets.

Garlic (Mars, Fire, Masculine) Garlic has always been seen as a vampire ward, but it can be used in other protection spells as well. It has been proven as a healing agent and is both antiviral and antifungal.

Nutmeg (Jupiter, Fire, Masculine) Nutmeg is carried for luck and to increase ESP. It has uses in many success and wealth spells. Drinking nutmeg as a brewed tea can produce hallucinations and is toxic in large quantities.

Rosemary (Sun, Fire, Masculine) Used in a variety of spells and magic work for protection, health, purifying, love and lust, exorcism and sleep. Burn it to cleanse spirits and a tea of rosemary can keep your mind sharp. Orally the herb helps stimulate circulation, digestion, and nerves. It will help soothe bad breath and depression.

## Animal Worship & North America Indians

# The Gods Are Within

I've watched Paganism in America change considerably in the last thirty years and I sometimes wonder what the next thirty will be like. As the New Year begins, it is often the case that we look both to the past and the future with wonder.

When I first became interested in Paganism, most of us called ourselves witches. If you wanted in on the fun, you had to really dig and show interest in just the right places and to the right people. Not much was written about us that wasn't 99% junk. And even the stuff that was real was full of weird explanations that you sort of had to work around in your mind before they made much sense. And if you were lucky enough to find anybody who actually knew what they were talking about it was like pulling teeth to get them to open up and tell it to you straight.

Then you had to wait about a thousand years before you were offered initiation. Well, maybe not quite that long, but it seemed like it. There weren't enough people who could or would initiate folks and you didn't get 'IN' unless you were initiated. At the time, when a high priest and/or priestess initiated someone, the initiate's magical behavior was the responsibility of the initiators. The etiquette was that if you had a dispute with someone, you either dealt with them directly to resolve it or you brought it before your elders. In most cases, the 'elders' were the priestess and priest that governed the coven. If the problem involved people of different covens, it would probably involve both covens' leaders.

By the mid to late eighties, the coven system of government and isolation was breaking down. This was due to several reasons but the most important one was because the definition of initiation was changing. The concept of self-initiation was gaining legitimacy and without a lineage of initiators, the authority of each coven to self-discipline was on the way out. This also eroded the confidentiality and secrecy that had been a cornerstone of the coven system. Covens had been much like the French WW II underground. Each group was a closed unit and only its leaders knew of the other covens, where they were, who led them, and what they did. There weren't any large festivals or celebrations as there are now. For the most part, coordination and communication between covens was limited to the leaders of the covens, a so-called 'gathering of Elders.' Occasionally, two or more covens would celebrate a sabbat or esbat with a related coven.

Eventually, books began to become available that gave just enough information to non-initiates that they began to practice magic and conduct their own celebrations. Before that time, every person initiated to the Craft was told that they were a priest or priestess. That is, they were considered to be responsible for the preservation and interpretation of their own spirituality. With self-initiation, a much larger group of people began to emerge who wanted to follow a path of magic and spirit but not lead it. The initiates of the coven system tried to respond and develop liturgy that didn't require the entire circle to be of the priesthood. But many of these chafed at the demands of clergy or simply didn't have the skills. Those who did step up made a big difference to the face of Paganism.

Covens still exist that maintain the initiate/priesthood format but they are few and far between, probably no even as numerous as in times past. Most covens today consist of a loose body of people following one or two leaders who have gained sufficient knowledge and skill to hold the group together. The differences, when compared to the old system, are

significant. Most importantly, today's covens usually aren't very exclusive or secret. Certainly that's not universally true, but it is for the majority. The general social culture in America today is nominally tolerant of most of Paganism's various forms of expression and most Pagans are not secretive about their spirituality.

There are now many open celebrations held throughout the year all over the USA and Canada as well as open circles for full and new moon services. Pagans of all stripes are now adopting forms very much like the Judeo-Christian religious organizations that dominate North America. They are forming churches that interact with the greater society in nearly exactly the same way as their much larger spiritual cousins.

It's almost inevitable once an organization begins to seek legitimacy and legal protection within the social order that they adopt the form and appearance that makes it easiest to receive those benefits. Ironically, the harassment of many Pagan groups during the eighties helped to cause those same groups to come out of the broom closet and demand the legal rights guaranteed to them by the laws of the society that sought to persecute them. The institutions developed in this more open setting are often held back by two problems: There aren't a great many qualified leaders, people who have the skills necessary to run an organized religious group. And there is not, as yet, the acceptance of the people who would use such an organization sufficient to support it.

No religious movement, and that is what modern Paganism is, ever starts out as an organized religion. It always develops as small groups and then grows. That growth is always beset with problems and disagreements among the groups but eventually some sort of common ground is reached and then the growth continues on a sporadic and somewhat confused basis for some time. Paganism has pretty much gotten over the 'witch wars' that seemed to dominate the nineties and now must face the challenges of the more conservative assimilation processes of becoming legitimate in the eyes of society.

I well remember the hue and cry set up by the secretive covens over the concept of self-initiation. The issue was not only the controversy of the idea but the impact it would have on the authenticity of lineage. It was feared, and rightly so, that the uncontrolled growth it would foster would destroy the coven system altogether. While it hasn't destroyed it, it has made a change in the direction and focus of our religious practices.

Modern institutionalized Paganism has created a whole new demand for qualified leadership and a material commitment from those who are to be its members.

It's impossible to know where Paganism will be and what it will look like in another thirty years, but it's probable that the next ten years will either drive it back underground or make it an important social voice in western society. It is up to everyone who seeks a balance within themselves between the dynamics of being human and the need for greater personal involvement with Spirit to determine what it will be like. Remember that gods are within each of us and how we worship them will be the deciding factor in how our world will survive.

# Spiritual Healing and Meditation

## **Meditation Can Be Effective as Part of Your Spiritual Healing Toolbox** **Laurie Kristensen**

To Access Deeper Levels of Spiritual Healing, Meditation Can Be the Key

One of the most common forms of spiritual meditation is Tibetan Healing Meditation. For many of us, our internal turmoil and angst is caused by our outer perceptions. The habit of constantly perceiving negative circumstances can very often prevent our personal growth. With the stunting of that growth comes a sense of hopelessness, defeat, and depression.

For people struggling with such negative energies, spiritual healing can serve as a major catalyst to personal growth. To access deeper levels of spiritual healing, some believers practice meditation.

Meditation serves as a method of focusing energy on the positive aspects of the surrounding environment rather than the negative. It aids in the healing process of an injured mind. It can lead to rejuvenation, revitalization, and renewal.

Most forms of meditation focus on breathing and relaxation techniques. These are used to reprogram the mind to lean towards the positive, rather than the negative. Meditation is usually done in a quiet, non-distracting atmosphere, though it could technically be practiced anywhere.

While meditation, participants are often asked to imagine specific images or to recite a phrase or sound. These "chants" help to center a person's energy and bring a sense of calmness to the mind.

One of the most common forms of spiritual meditation is Tibetan Healing Meditation. In this type of meditation, the chant that is often said is similar to a prayer in the Western tradition. The chant asks the Green Tara, a Tibetan Goddess, for her blessings and approval.

Spiritual healing in the Tibetan tradition can also include raising prayer flags, constructing prayer wheels, and embarking upon spiritual pilgrimages. These are all meant to heal an individual physically and spiritually.

Tibetan culture has always been steadfast in their spiritual and practical beliefs. They are careful to balance the two worlds to keep both psychological and physiological systems in sync. Meditation is an important element in this difficult balancing act.

The Tibetan form of healing meditation is especially effective for those ailing from stress-related illnesses. Stress is often caused by the imbalance of the spiritual and practical worlds. Meditation helps to balance these thought processes to put the person at ease both spiritually and physically.

Meditation and stress release enhance personal health and longevity. It helps a person take responsibility for their own mental state of being. It shows that we are not controlled by the actions of those around us, but by the way we perceive those actions and internalize them.

Meditation increases our awareness of both ourselves and others as well as helping us figure out how to deal with everyday problems. Anyone who practices meditation has the potential to reap considerable benefits that will last long after the meditative state has been achieved.

If you have existing health conditions, using spiritual healing methods to treat medical conditions at the expense of seeking conventional medical help is not recommended. However, when used to complement conventional medicine, many people have found these treatments to be very effective. At the very least, they might offer a welcome sense of hope to someone who desperately needs some.

Although some forms of spiritual healing have been around much longer than the conventional medicine of today, they can - and often do -- work very well together. In fact, it is not recommended that any method of spiritual or complementary healing be used alone to treat medical conditions, although many of the methods can stand alone when used to tackle issues such as stress relief.

And when thinking about what "spiritual healing" is - the mind, body, and spirit working together as one in optimal balance - it's easy to understand that conventional medicine and spiritual healing are not mutually exclusive.
