Runes

Waes Hael! And welcome to what is increasingly inaccurately called my runes column. Have no fear I shall get back to the topic of runes again soon However this week I would like to remain with Heathenry.

This weekend coming is the Lustration of the Ancestors where I am lecturing/ running a workshop on runes. (See I did mention runes after all) I wont spoil it for those attending by going into the lecture material here; but it suddenly occurred to me while I was thinking of what to write; that I should perhaps investigate what a ritual in celebration of our ancestors would be like if a group of Heathens were gathered together.

Firstly I have to say that looking at historical sources can be helpful but also confusing if you are looking for one way in which to conduct an authentic Heathen ritual. There were many different ways recorded from different times and different places. Pete Jennings in his new book: Heathen Paths Cappall Bann 2007 (I don't mind giving his book a plug because 1/ it is very good and 2/ he was nice enough to sign my copy!) makes the point that some traditions which were perfectly acceptable in one place were taboo in another. As a specific example He gives Gothis being allowed to ride stallions in Iceland but not in England.

So what about the ancestors then? Well Heathens view their ancestors as being part of who they are. That we are the product of our ancestors; going back through all the generations to the Gods. So respect for the ancestors is as important and Troth with the Aesir and Vanir.

An important part of any Heathen ritual has to be the Symbel (Sumbel) which is a ritual toast; usually drunk using mead and also usually a shared drinking horn or chalice. Though I have led a ritual where everybody had their own vessel and drank each time a toast was made. If you ever have a mind to do this, make it at the end of the ritual; and ensure that if you are leading it that you only take sips not gulps. That way there is at least one person left standing to close the ritual.

There are ways of doing a Symbel without getting the whole circle drunk and normally I would say that if you are going to be doing any kind of magical working then you should be sober and in control. This is especially true if you are going to be risting runes and using sharp tools. However I have thought about this for a long time and I really do think that: getting drunk in that situation in that ritual fitted what we were trying to achieve. After all our ancestors who are feasting with Odin in Valhalla are hardly staying sober!

The other thing that springs to mind that might have a place in a Heathen ritual: is singing songs and sagas about the deeds of our ancestors. No everybody can sing or make up poetry on the spot like the ancient skalds. Instead you could simply tell a story about one of your ancestors and at the end everybody would drink a toast to them. That would also slow the drinking down a little!

A-Z of Religions - Shinto

The essence of Shinto is the Japanese devotion to invisible spiritual beings and powers called kami, to shrines, and to various rituals.

Shinto is not a way of explaining the world. What matters are rituals that enable human beings to communicate with kami.

Kami are not God or gods. They are spirits that are concerned with human beings - they appreciate our interest in them and want us to be happy - and if they are treated properly they will intervene in our lives to bring benefits like health, business success, and good exam results.

Shinto is a very local religion, in which devotees are likely to be concerned with their local shrine rather than the religion as a whole. Many Japanese will have a tiny shrine-altar in their homes.

However, it is also an unofficial national religion with shrines that draw visitors from across the country. Because ritual rather than belief is at the heart of Shinto, Japanese people don't usually think of Shinto specifically as a religion - it's simply an aspect of Japanese life. This has enabled Shinto to coexist happily with Buddhism for centuries.

- The name Shinto comes from Chinese characters for Shen ('divine being'), and Tao ('way') and means 'Way of the Spirits'.
- Shrine visiting and taking part in festivals play a great part in binding local communities together.
- Shrine visiting at New Year is the most popular shared national event in Japan.
- Because Shinto is focussed on the land of Japan it is clearly an ethnic religion. Therefore Shinto is little interested in missionary work, and rarely practised outside its country of origin.
- Shinto sees human beings as basically good and has no concept of original sin, or of humanity as 'fallen'.
- Everything, including the spiritual, is experienced as part of this world. Shinto has no place for any transcendental other world.
- Shinto has no canonical scriptures.
- Shinto teaches important ethical principles but has no commandments.
- Shinto has no founder, has no God and does not require adherents to follow it as their only religion
