Veterinary Notes H is for hemorrhage

Most dog owners are bound to experience at least one minor hemorrhage when their dog steps on some of the pieces of broken glass that litter our countryside and streets. Be particularly wary of ponds in areas frequented by teenagers for these are often full of broken bottles and are best avoided.

If your dog cuts its pad, immediately check the wound to see how much it is bleeding. If it is a steady ooze, remove any obvious bits of glass and apply a firm pressure till the bleeding slows. Take your dog to the veterinary surgeon as soon as possible because the dog will need antibiotics at the very least.

If the blood is coming out in spurts, this is a major emergency. An artery has been severed and the dog could bleed to death. Again apply firm pressure over the wound until you can summon assistance. If pressure is insufficient to stop the blood, knot the dog's lead; a scarf or anything long and flexible, around the leg to make a tourniquet and tighten it till the bleeding stops. Don't be surprised at the degree of tightness required. Loosen the tourniquet slightly every 15 minutes till a **slight** ooze of blood begins and then retighten. Go to the veterinary surgeon without delay, warning them by phone in advance so that they will have theatre ready.

It is not only glass that poses a problem. Sticks are a common cause of injury which may be very serious when the dog runs onto the sharp end. This usually happens when the owner is throwing sticks for the dog. It is best to throw a ball or kong and avoid sticks which may also cause mouth injuries. Running onto a stick causes a stab wound and a particularly vulnerable area for such wounds is the groin which is home to the femoral artery, the main artery of the leg. I have seen a dog die because of a stick wound in this area. As with the paw injuries, if you see pumping blood apply immediate pressure. If it is coming from the femoral artery you will need to apply considerable force. The first aid advice for such an injury in humans is to apply pressure with your foot, using your body weight to increase the pressure for the flow in this artery is so strong. A dog may not need quite this amount of pressure, but it gives an idea of the force required. Keep this pressure up continually until you can reach your veterinary surgeon. It is best to take your dog to the surgery yourself alerting them by phone so that they will be ready to take the dog into theatre immediately, and so that they can round up possible blood donors (usually dogs owned by members of the practice).

Haemorrhage may also occur internally for many reasons including trauma. Non-traumatic causes include tumours of the spleen, and blood cancers. Often the haemorrhage is the first sign of problems and may be indicated by collapse. If you look at the dog's gums they will appear almost snow white. Again, this is an emergency and prompt treatment is essential. Prognosis is very poor but a few dogs may be saved through prompt surgery and/or blood transfusion.

With any form of haemorrhage, forewarned is forearmed. Try to remain calm and unflustered at the sight of blood and concentrate on dealing with the problem. As a first-aid instructor in secondary school once said – "you can panic afterwards!" It is good advice.

A-Z of Dragons

WANTLEY DRAGON

Origin: England
