Merry Meet Everyone!

While we have been getting the winter remedies kit checked out the weather here has gone from bad to worse then back again, that spring the birds and I were fondly imagining, has bolted back into the rabbit hole and we are facing quite chilly weather.

This coming weekend it is going to be even chillier for me as I am traveling to Sydney to attend my son's wedding. Under the Blue Mountains in August is a place I have a large collection of childhood memories of, and none of them include being warm. ☺

The August westerly's are already blowing they tell me, and I would like a dollar for each of the times I have been advised to "bring warm clothes". So armed with plenty of warm jumpers and my chicken soup recipe I am off to what was fondly known as "out in the sticks" when I was a girl.

My recipe for chicken soup hasn't changed much since my grandmother gave it to me 50 years ago, and really isn't that different to any one else's I guess but I thought I would share it with you any way, as it is part of my winter remedy standby list.

My grandmother was a good cook, she made the best Lamingtons in the world, ☺ LOL

Why do I have Chicken soup in my arsenal of winter remedies?

Well, Broth is fabulous food and amazing medicine. Real home made broth, that is. We make real broth from bones, it is simmered for hours, sometimes even days. When we make a broth at home it is so full of gelatin that it thickens and makes a jelly as it cools (I am sure your Grandmothers remember calf's foot jelly, same principle). This gives us Minerals, and Proteins as well as a wonderful flavor. And then you add the vegetables and herbs.

Grandma's Chicken Soup

Use:

- 6x chicken carcasses, submerged in a decent size stockpot with a heaped teaspoon of the coarse Celtic sea salt.
- Bring it to a simmer and turn it down.
- Skim off the scum that rises to the surface.
- Then leave it to simmer. Skim every half hour or so or when it needs it.
- When the meat starts to fall off the bones, take them out, pick the meat off, set it aside, and return the bones to the pot to simmer.
- Leave it simmering for as many hours as you can stand it.
- Make sure the water covers the bones at all times, Best left for a full day to simmer, this brings out the goodness and the flavour.
- When satisfied that the broth has simmered for long enough, strain the broth.
- Use this broth as the base for your chicken soup..
- Add the rest of the ingredients to create your soup,

- Some vegetables, choose from carrots, turnips, parsnips, sweet potatoes, kale, peppers, tomatoes, sauteed onions, sauteed mushrooms, garlic, potatoes, rice, barley, and some herbs; basil, thyme, oregano, cumin, coriander, cinnamon, ginger, garlic... (fresh basil and garlic are great).
- You can choose your vegetables and flavorings based on the medicinal herbs you want to use. For winter, you might choose warming herbs like ginger and cinnamon and black pepper. Onions and carrots might go well with them. Holy basil and cinnamon also make a nice combination. I like garlic, and I like it strong, so I usually wait to add it until the soup is almost finished cooking. (This also preserves some of the medicinal properties of the garlic and stops it from getting a bitter taste.)
- Once your vegetables etc, are added to the broth bring it back to a simmer.
- Taste for salt. Keep it simmering until all the ingredients are done. Taste again, season it and add any last minute ingredients. Enjoy!
- [To make broth from the bones of your roast chicken, just put them in a pot, cover them with water, bring it very slowly to a simmer, turn the heat down and let it brew. A few hours is probably enough for chicken bones, but overnight is always better if you have the patience.]

A Quicker Chicken soup for those with little time on their hands but who still prefer the made the day before flavour.

INGREDIENTS

- 2 Carrots
- 3 Stalks Celery
- 1 Onion
- 2-3 cloves of garlic
- 1 Chicken
- 250ml Chicken stock (salt reduced)
- 1 packet Udon Noodles
- Water
- Salt & Pepper

Method

1. Wash the chicken to remove any blood and excess salt
2. In a large pot, add chicken, whole carrots, celery and chicken stock and enough water to cover meat and vegetables and cook for approx 1.5 hrs.
3. Strain the soup removing the vegetables and chicken.
4. Chop the vegetables and pull the chicken meat of the bones returning it to the soup.
5. Cool overnight and skim the fat off the top.

Boil the noodles separately with some salt then add to the reheated soup.

And a twenty minute, soup in a hurry.

INGREDIENTS

- ¼ cup Butter
- 1 Onion (Peeled And Chopped)
- 2 Celery Roots (Peeled And Chopped Into Small Pieces)

- 1½L Chicken Or Vegetable Broth
- 1 teaspoon Dried Thyme (Or Fresh Thyme)
- Salt & Pepper (To Taste)

Method

1. In a 4-quart saucepan, sauté the onion in the butter until it just begins to caramelize.
2. Add the celery root, chicken broth, thyme, salt and pepper and bring to a simmer.
3. Cook until the celery root is tender, about twenty minutes.
4. Smoothly puree the soup with an immersion blender, a counter-top blender or a food processor.

An Asian version for those who like a light soup

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Small Package Soba Noodles
- 2 cups Orange Juice
- 2 cups Chicken Stock
- 2in Piece Of Ginger (frozen)
- 1 tablespoon Soy Sauce
- 1 cup Sliced Green Onion
- 2 cups Baby Bok Choy (Chopped)
- 1 cup Bean Sprout
- 1 Carrot (Grated)
- 1 tablespoon Sesame Seed

Method

1. Bring a large pot of water to a boil.
2. Season with salt and then add soba noodles.
3. Boil just until they have softened, about 3-5 minutes.
4. Drain and rinse.
5. Bring orange juice and chicken stock to a simmer.
6. Grate in frozen ginger, reserving some for garnish and add soya sauce, green onions, bok choy, sprouts and carrot.
7. Stir until bok choy is wilted.
8. Place some soba noodles into soup bowls.
9. Ladle in some broth and vegetables and garnish with sesame seeds and grated ginger.

I hope you enjoy these winter standbys.

They are so full of proteins and minerals that it is no wonder that our grandmothers (and their grandmothers) always had some on the back of the stove when winter chills, coughs and colds were in season.

May you enjoy your week and may the bluebird of happiness nest in your front yards.

Runes

Waes Hael!

Last week as I wrote my article I was preparing to lead the Lughnassadh ritual for my local eclectic hearth. So this week I am going to be exceptionally lazy and copy parts of it for you to see. I start off with a welcome that I have used before in other rituals. I have provided explanations and commentary (in brackets and smaller type) There were seven of us present I was acting as Gothi, other people took the rest of the parts.

Herald: may first blow a horn, strike a gong, or beat a drum

(We started the ritual, and ended it, with the Herald blowing three blasts on a reproduction battle horn made in Denmark)

“ Pagan brethren gathered here, I call upon you to come and pay respects to the old Gods and Goddesses of the North. In song dance and drumbeat, we now offer a token of our troth.

Be cheerful of heart; clear of mind; hale in body and untroubled in spirit. For the circle is about to be closed and the festival celebration is about to begin!”

Cleansing and blessing the Harrow

(This part is taken from the deluding of Gylfi, which is part of the Prose Edda. I have used it as a scene setter and also as a framework in which to place the blessing of the holy fire and water. The parts ‘Just as High’ and ‘Third’ are two of the lords that Gylfi is asking questions of. It is also a cleansing and a calling of the quarters since I have only used North and South in this ritual and the corresponding elements of Ice and Fire)

Just as High: "It was many ages before the earth was shaped that the Mist-World was made; and midmost within it lies the well that is called Hvergelmir, from which spring ten rivers.

Gothi: Svöl, Gunnthrá, Fjörm, Fimbulthul, Slídr and Hríd, Sylgr and Ylgr, Víd, Leiptr; Gjöll whose mighty waters flowed into Gunningagap, In your memory I purify this water and drive out any energy harmful to our rite.

(we used water from the North Atlantic in this ritual to represent the rivers flowing out of Niflheim from the melting ice. It says later in the Edda that the Ice was salty.)

Third: "Yet first was the world in the southern region, which was named Múspell; it is light and hot; that region is glowing and burning, and impassable (to anyone not native to that place.)

Gothi: Nine woods in the Cauldron go, burn them fast and burn them slow.

As each line is spoken so the corresponding wood is added to the brazier. **Except for Elder** which is held aloft and then placed on the Altar

**Birch in the fire goes- to represent what the Lady knows.
Oak in the forest towers with might- in the fire it brings the God's insight.**

**Rowan is a tree of power- causing life and magick to flower.
Willows at the waterside- stand ready to help us to the Summerland.
Hawthorn is burned to purify- and to draw faerie to your eye.
Hazel the tree of wisdom and learning- adds its strength to the bright fire burning.
White are the flowers of Apple tree- that brings us fruits of fertility.
Grapes grow upon the vine- giving us both joy and wine.
Fir does mark the evergreen- to represent immortality seen.
Elder is the Lady's tree- burn it not or cursed you'll be.**

Gothi: Spoiler of twigs and scorcher of Grimmir, I call upon the Aesir and Vanir that you might be purified for our rite.

(Those of you who have read the Wiccan rede in its entirety and not just the last 2 lines will recognise the nine woods charm that I have used to consecrate the fire. This worked quite well. There was a central altar and I had set up a small barBQ as a brazier in the south to represent Muspell and in which to burn the woods. We circled the Altar each saying one line at a time and placing the relevant stick in the fire as we read that line.)

(spoiler of twigs and Scorcher of Grimmir are both kennings for fire)

Just as High: "Ginnungagap, which faced toward the northern quarter, became filled with heaviness, and masses of ice and rime, and from within, drizzling rain and gusts; but the southern part of the Yawning Void was lighted by those sparks and glowing masses which flew out of Múspellheim.

Third: "Just as cold arose out of Niflheim, and all terrible things. So also all that looked toward Múspellheim became hot and glowing; but Ginnungagap was as mild as windless air. And when the breath of heat met the rime, so that it melted and dripped, life was quickened from the yeast-drops, by the power of that which sent the heat, and became a man's form. And that man is named Ymir.

Gothi: Takes water and sprinkles it over the fire to make steam.

By the meeting of water and fire was the first life made in the formless void on Gunningagap. With water and fire do I create this sacred space.

Join hands in a circle.

All: Sprits of this place, Lords and Ladies of Aesir and Vanir we mark this place as sacred and beyond this world. May all in it be cleansed by the power of fire and water. May all negative thoughts be banished and all harmful spirits expelled. By our will, so be it!

I hope you have found this interesting. The Idea to use just two elements for a Heathen ritual is not mine but was given to me by Pete Jennings at a conference he was speaking at earlier this year. The readings from the Edda come from the 1916 translation of the prose Edda by Arthur Gilchrist Brodeur.

I thank the Goddess for the good thing that she has provided with during the summer, and asked for some more things that She could help us with for the future. It's so we can get a closure on some things that has been going on for about 6 months or so, now. Hopefully, She will help us in that matter.

I do love my life as it has turned out to be, and I am still pinching myself to really understand that it's not a dream. If anyone had told me about 1 ½ years ago, that I would be living the life I am now I should have said that they were silly, as it's has been a dream for about 9 years to me. I can't thank the Goddess enough, for letting me have my dream come through.

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A-Z of Dragons

YAM BOY

Origin: Korea

A woman married the dragon of a nearby lake and had a boy who made money by digging yams. He fell in love with a princess, but her father sent her away from him. He followed and they were married. She gave him gold for them to live on and he said that there was a lot of it (gold) where he'd found his yams, so they got the gold and were very wealthy.

YAM-NAHAR

Origin: Canaanite

Yam-nahar is the 7 headed sea serpent-god or dragon-god of Canaanite myths. He is also called: Yam, "Sir Sea", "Sir Stream", Yaw, Yamu, "Prince Sea", "Judge River", Tannin, Primeval Serpent, Lotan, Crooked Serpent, Sea Monster, close-coiling One, Tyrant of Seven Heads He represents floods, oceans, and winter. El made him king. He lives in a palace in the sea. His followers may be dragons, serpents, and the Leviathan. He fights with Baal and is finally destroyed by Baal.

YELLOW DRAGON

Origin: China

Yellow Dragons are a class of dragons in the legends of China.

One notable Yellow Dragon in Chinese history is the dragon who brought the eight trigrams of the I Ching to the Chinese Emperor. A second Yellow Dragon was a monstrous predator, which was dispatched by one of the Eight Immortal Holy Ones named Lu Tung-pin. Finally, a third Yellow Dragon was called Svara, a vast dragon with an enormous horn upon its head.

YING LUNG

Origin: China

He is also known as the Proper Conduct Dragon. Ying Lung differs from a lot of Chinese dragons as it is shown with wings, but like others it is a guardian of the waters of earth, and associated with the clouds of heaven.

YOFUNE-NUSHI

Origin: Japan

Yofune-Nushi is the name of a sea serpent in Japanese legend. It lived near Oki Island in a cave by the rocks and was both predatory and destructive. It would frequently cause storms to rise and it preyed upon the fishermen and inhabitants of the islands remorselessly.

The serpent demanded a maiden be sacrificed each year on the 13th of June, otherwise it would call a storm to destroy the fishermen's fleet.

One year a girl called Tokoyo came forward to be the sacrifice and bravely stood and faced the serpent. As it reached down to eat her she pulled out the dagger she was carrying and slashed at Yofune-Nushi's eyes. While it was thrashing in agony she was able to push the dagger into its vulnerable throat and kill it.

YULUNGGU

Origin: Australia

Yulunggu is the name of the Rainbow Snake, or Rainbow Serpent, in the Dreamtime mythology of the Yolngu Native Australian people of Arnhem Land of northern Australia.

Yulunggu inhabited deep-water pools and was a vast serpent. There is a legend about some sisters named Borlere and Misilgoe who camped by the pool of Yulunggu without realising he was there. They tried to cook on their fire to be able to feed their girl and boy but everything jumped away from them and into the pool. Yulunggu then caused a great flood and the sisters realised something was not right so they started chanting and dancing to try to keep Yulunggu from their children.

Soon they were exhausted and fell asleep by the pool. During the night Yulunggu arose from the water and swallowed them all whole. He went to heaven and started boasting about what he had done, but swallowing humans was not approved and he was told so. Yulunggu then descended back to earth and regurgitated, it is not said if the sisters or their children suffered any ill effects from their ordeal.

The legend is often re-enacted as part of the traditional puberty rites for young boys and girls.
