Runes

Waes Hael!

Last week I promised to bring you some of the lesser known Gods and Goddesses. I had intended that it should be a demonstration of the scant information which we have about some of the Aesir and the Vanir. However I have managed to delve deeper into the Scandinavian Lore of the Ynglingas Saga and have found information not in either of the Eddas.

So let us look at Gefion, sometimes also written as Gefjon. Not to be confused with Gefn who is a completely different Goddess. My first port of call as always was the Poetic Edda where she is only mentioned as one of the many Gods and Goddesses who quarrelled with Loki in Aegir's hall. Loki's Quarrel Verse 20 gives Loki's Taunt to Gefion.

Be silent, Gefion, I'm going to mention this,
How your heart was seduced
The white boy gave you a jewel
And you laid your thigh over him.

(Trans. Larrington 1996)

As is quite often the case with the Eddas this is entirely cryptic and is dependent on the reader knowing the lore it is talking about. Obviously there is more to this story.

Looking next I saw that there was a footnote which gave the possible source of the story as the Ynglingas Saga. Which is one of the Sagas that I don't possess in book form. So it was off to www.Sacred-texts.com to read the Ynglingas Saga.

Talking of Odin's actions it says:

Then he sent Gefion across
the sound to the north to discover new countries; and she came to
King Gylve, who gave her a ploughgate of land. Then she went to
Jotunheim, and bore four sons to a giant, and transformed them
into a yoke of oxen. She yoked them to a plough, and broke out
the land into the ocean right opposite to Odins. This land was
called Sealand, and there she afterwards settled and dwelt.
Skjold, a son of Odin, married her, and they dwelt at Leidre.
Where the ploughed land was is a lake or sea called Laage. In
the Swedish land the fjords of Laage correspond to the nesses in
Sealand. Brage the Old sings thus of it: --

"Gefion from Gylve drove away,
To add new land to Denmark's sway --
Blythe Gefion ploughing in the smoke
That steamed up from her oxen-yoke:
Four heads, eight forehead stars had they,
Bright gleaming, as she ploughed away;
Dragging new lands from the deep main
To join them to the sweet isle's plain.

Snorri Sturlson
(c.1179-1241)
Samuel Laing (London, 1844), translator.

This is the same King Gylve or Gylfi who we find in the Prose Edda being deluded by Odin. Not surprisingly since both texts are by the same Author we get a very similar tale at the start of the Deluding of Gylfi.

A ploughgate of land is as much as one man (or Goddess) can plough in one day. Interestingly many of my local place names are of Viking origin and many of them end in 'gate' meaning 'road to' for example 'Heanor Gate'. So you could also say that it is as much land as you can travel over with a team of ox in a day.

The only extra information we gain is that Gefion disguised herself as a beggar woman, and that the land was given to her as reward for the way she had entertained him. Most writers seem to think this is the 'white boy' that Loki was referring to when casting aspersions on Gefion's honour. So we can only guess what kind of 'entertainment' it was!

Both Saga and Edda make the remark that you can see that there are as many bays in the lake as there are headlands in Zealand. However as John Grant observes in his book 'An Introduction to Viking Mythology' if you look at Zealand and Lake Malaren on a map you will see "they are of vastly different sizes".

Later in the prose Edda we find Gefion in the list of notable Goddesses as a virgin who all unmarried women go to when they die. She is also listed in the poetic Diction as one of the Goddesses who sat in judgement when Aegir came visiting the Aesir.

This first attribute does seem at odds with the earlier story of her bearing four sons by a Giant in order to fool King Gylfi. Perhaps to the ancient people having sex with a giant did not count! Yet there are a great many tales of the Gods and the Giants pairing up for example Niord and Skadi. However the Ynglingas Saga goes on to describe her marriage to one of the sons of Odin. Maybe there is another Gefion who is a virgin!

The Tarot card for today is The Moon

Message of The Moon

Pink Flowers

Common Name: **Sea pink**
Genus: *Armeria*
Species: *juniperifolia*
Cultivar: 'Bevan's Variety'
Skill Level: **Beginner**
Exposure: **Full sun**
Hardiness: **Hardy**
Soil type: **Well-drained/light, Moist**
Height: **5cm**
Spread: **10cm**
Time to plant seeds: **September to May**
Time to divide plants: **March to April**



Related to the popular thrift, *Armeria juniperifolia* makes a neat plant with tightly packed rosettes made up of narrow, needle-like leaves radiating outwards to make starry shapes. In late spring, the mounds bear clusters of deep rosy-pink flowers which sit among the foliage - they have virtually no stem. Since the plants are so tiny they are easily swamped by more vigorous species, and are best grown in a raised bed or alpine sink. Also known as *A. caespitosa*. The Royal Horticultural Society has given it its prestigious Award of Garden Merit (AGM).

This plant has tight rosettes of fine, needle-like, greenish-grey leaves. The flowers grow in dense clusters. They are small, cup-shaped pink flowers that open in late spring, held on short stems above the fine foliage.

Enquire Within for Everything (Well Almost!!)

Merry Meet Everyone,

I have been missing again I know but now with the help of the Divine I am back and working to capacity. I do thank our dear Editor and you the readers for your patience.

This week I have some recipes to share with you, not my own but there do come with my hearty recommendation to those who require ideas for meals with no dairy or wheat products.

I retrieved these from a newsletter put out by a naturopath of my acquaintance here in Australia called John Coleman. He is a remarkable man who has struggled against and suffered with Parkinson's Disease and who has conquered this disabling malady.

Conquered it to the extent of being able to travel and lecture and to also running a highly successful practice using the methods he and his associates have developed to improve the lives of Parkinson's patients.

Below are two recipes, both of which contain **no wheat or dairy product**, taste great and are easy to make.

NOTE: Nutritional Yeast, as used in these recipes, is deactivated, vegan-compatible yeast that tastes "nutty" or "cheesy", and can be used in many dishes as a substitute for soft cheese or parmesan.

It is **NOT** the same as brewers yeast or torula yeast.

Nutritional yeast is high in protein and the B vitamins, plus other minerals.

Brands in Australia/New Zealand include Marigold Engevita, in USA there is Red Star and others.

Search the internet for brands and outlets near you. Some bulk food stores/co-ops have this yeast in bulk.

There are several books advertised on the internet including many recipes containing Nutritional Yeast, such as "The Ultimate Uncheese Cookbook" and "the Nutritional Yeast Cookbook", both by Jo Stepaniak.

CREAMY PASTA SAUCE:

I use this sauce whenever I want that creamy texture and flavour with my non-wheat pasta dish or stir fry.

You will need:

- 1 x 400ml can coconut cream,
- 3/4 to 1 tablespoon almond paste,
- 1 tablespoon Laksa or curry paste (to taste),
- 1 tablespoon tamari or red wine (or combination),
- 2 tablespoons nutritional yeast.

Method:

Combine almond paste, laksa/curry paste, tamari/wine and nutritional yeast in a medium bowl. This will take a little determination as the almond paste is quite sticky; however, as you stir, it will become easier to blend with the other ingredients.

Once blended, add the coconut cream and stir well.

Add to your pasta sauce or stir fry about five minutes before removing from the heat. It's easy and very tasty.

MACARONI CHEESE:

This dish contains no wheat or dairy, yet tastes delicious (better than traditional macaroni cheese I reckon) and is good for you.

You will need:

3 QT/3L casserole dish (approx 30 x 9 x 2 inch)

Ingredients:

3 1/2 – 4 cups Uncooked NON-wheat elbow macaroni (i.e. buckwheat, quinoa, corn or rice). If you cannot find “elbow” macaroni in a non-wheat form, it’s best to have a small “tubed” form of pasta. Large tubes tend to collapse. With un-tubed pasta you’ll need more than the above listed amount).

3 1/2 cups Boiling Water

1/2 cup Oat Flour or Buckwheat Flour (or some other NON-wheat flour option)

1/2 cup Olive oil

1/4 cup Grapeseed oil

2 Tablespoons Tamari Sauce (non-wheat soy sauce)

1 1/2 teaspoons Garlic Powder

1 teaspoon Salt

1 cup Nutritional Yeast Flakes

Optional ingredients:

1+ teaspoon of Minced Garlic (fresh or jar – fresh is more flavourful, thus less is required)

Oat Bran crumbs

Pinch of Turmeric

Paprika

Sesame Seeds

Cook non-wheat macaroni pasta (al dente) in a separate saucepan while making the non-dairy “cheese” in another large saucepan. Place macaroni in casserole dish when cooked.

To make non-dairy “cheese”:

Warm olive oil over low heat in large saucepan.

Beat in flour with a wire whisk and continue to beat over a medium flame until the mixture (called a roux) is smooth and bubbly.

Whip in boiling water, salt, tamari sauce, and garlic powder (optional at this point is to also add turmeric and/or minced garlic to taste).

Beat well to dissolve the roux.

The sauce should cook until it thickens and bubbles.

Then whip in grapeseed oil and nutritional yeast flakes.

Mix part of the sauce with the noodles in the casserole dish.

Pour a generous amount of sauce over the top.

If desired, lightly sprinkle top with oat bran crumbs and/or sesame seeds and/or paprika.
Bake for 15 minutes in a 350F/160C pre-heated oven.
Put under broiler/griller for a few minutes until “cheese” sauce gets a bit crisp or light brown color.

I hope you enjoy these recipes and find many ways to use the non-dairy cheese to your advantage. More next time.
