Lady Krystal Retires

Letter From Lady Krystal

Dear friends,

As you may recall I attempted to retire from the office of First Priestess a few years ago. At that time circumstances arose which convinced me that I needed to resume that office as acting First Priestess, temporarily, as the Tradition was going through turmoil. Although I continued to be pressed by those issues which prompted my desire to retire, I did not mind returning to active service at a time when the Tradition needed me, as I felt my place was at the side of the First Priest, Rev. Don Lewis.

Now the Tradition is on an even keel, healthy and balanced, and my guides have been pressuring me for some time now not only to retire from active service as First Priestess, but to retire from active service in all of the duties of a Priestess of any rank. This is the official announcement of that retirement. The condition of my energy, and a few health challenges, while not serious, are among the issues that made me see the wisdom of my guide's advice.

In consultation with the First Priest, the Rev. Don Lewis, he and I agree it would be a mistake to attempt to force-fit a new First Priestess pre-maturely. Instead the First Priest shall act as Regent for my offices, until such time as a clear heir becomes apparent. In the meantime many of the duties of the First Priestess will be assigned to various leading High Priestesses. My office of Grand Oracle will be assumed by the First Priest in his own right. I will however retain Headship of The Order of World Walkers until mid-June when all of the active students will have become full-fledged members of the order. At that time the First Priest will assume leadership of The Order of World Walkers. Any students who have put their studies in the Order on hold may resume them at that time under the First Priest. The First Priest will also now become Head of The Temple of The Dancers of Shakti.

I wish to emphasize that this is not a resignation but a retirement, and that I fully and strongly support our Tradition.

I have been proud and honored to be First Priestess of a Tradition which has so many wonderful, warm, talented and dedicated people as its members. I am awed by the quality of this membership. With this kind of support the Tradition can only continue to grow and to thrive, achieving the purposes for which it was created. I send my love to all of you and thank you for the joy and blessings I have known as First Priestess.

Runes

*Do you know how to carve, do you know how to interpret,
Do you know how to stain, do you know how to test out,
Do you know how to ask, do you know how to sacrifice,
Do you know how to dispatch, do you know how to slaughter?*

Sayings of the high one v144 Trans Carolyne Larrington 1996

Sacrifice. That's where we are at. What is most peoples image of sacrifice? Is it perhaps a freshly slaughtered goat? Or perhaps a chalice poured out? Then again is it something as simple as time and effort put into something? The short answer is that whatever peoples perceptions of sacrifice is it has been largely flavoured with Christian teachings. These are that Jesus was sacrificed to save us all and no further sacrifices are required. Indeed any sacrifices offered are to be considered not Christian and therefore evil and made to the Devil. Of course when we are talking about Christianity and the devil we have to realise that we are not being taught through love here but through fear and threat. The aim isn't to make us better people but to scare us into asking the Lord to save us. All of which is actually quite long for a short answer.

Runes don't have any such illusions or ulterior motives. Quite simply they work as a balance. IE if you are using them for magic and you want the magic to work then you have to ask yourself what it is going to cost you and what you are willing to pay. Rather than being filled with energy from 'The Goddess' and using that energy in your magic then simply thanking the Goddess and grounding excess: the Runes have their own power independent of any deity. They have their own magic contained in each of them and this is released by correct risting of that rune. This process in itself builds up energy as you shape and carve the rune then paint it. You are putting your time and energy into the rune. Then the rune is empowered to work as is the nature of that rune. You have made that sacrifice, all the more if you have decided to use some of your own blood in the paint. This risting binds that rune to you and sets it working to your purpose. You can dedicate it to work and call on other Gods to bless it afterwards if that feels right but the magic is already working. That balance has to be equalised, you have put energy into one side of the equation the magic has to work in order to make the equation balance.

Heathens largely reject a universal view of deity; even though the theory does make sense. We have an intensely personal relationship with our Gods and Goddesses which makes any higher theory as to where they fit in the greater scheme of things seem pretty irrelevant. This is also seen in our approach to rune magic. It is not just shifting the energy of the universe around to suit our own ends. It is using our own energy to shift the universe to our own ends. That is sacrifice.

Yule Crafts

Materials:

- 1 Wood craft ring
- 1 Sheet of green paper
- 2 Pkg green crinkled, shredded paper
- 1 Bunch of fake berries
- 12 Inches of any kind of ribbon (it best to use the kind with wire so you can bend it)
- Hot glue gun

Instructions:

All items can usually be bought at dollar stores!

Take the green paper and trace the wooden ring on it; cut it out (cut the center out too). Hot glue the green paper ring onto the wooden ring.

Take the shredded, crinkled paper and glue it onto the green ring, making sure you cover the entire ring. Then, take the berries and glue them individually on to the green crinkled paper wherever desired. If you want, you can make a bow and glue it onto the wreath.

Instructions to make a wreath using pine cones and a wire coat hanger.

A fun gift idea or a great Christmas decoration.

Materials Needed:

- 8 Pine Cones (approximate)
- Wire Coat Hanger
- Duct Tape
- Items to decorate your wreath
- Glue



Instructions:

Cut the wire coat hanger in half and form it into a circle. Wind the two ends together. I then secured the ends and covered the entire circle with duct tape. This held it together better and gave the pine cones a better surface to stick to!

Once you have your circle formed, glue on the pine cones (a hot glue gun worked best for me). Decorate as desired. I added a ribbon and holly made out of crafting Foam. I added red beads for the holly berries.

If you want a larger wreath, just do not cut the wire hanger in half! :-)

Instructions to make a simple Christmas wreath using garland and paper plates.

Materials Needed:

- 2 Paper Plates
- Stapler
- Garland
- Tape
- Glue
- Ribbon

Instructions:

Cut the center out of both paper plates. Hold the paper plates so the edges line up and the bottom parts face out. Staple around the edges to hold the paper plates together.

You can use whatever color garland you want. It should be at least 4 feet long, but longer is better! Tape one end of the garland so it is tucked inside the middle gap in the paper plates. Start wrapping the garland around the circle formed by the paper plates. You want to cover the plates completely. When you get back to where you started, put a blob of glue on the end of the garland and tuck it carefully inside the middle gap of the paper plates.

Fluff out the garland.

Tie a ribbon into a bow and glue it onto your wreath. You can also decorate it with light-weight mini ornaments, candy canes, or shapes cut out of scrap fabric or construction paper.

The Yule Log

Perhaps one of the oldest of all Pagan Yuletide traditions is the burning of the Yule log. At this, the coldest & darkest time of the year, the burning of the Yule log, expressed in the simplest magickal terms what was needed most: warmth & light. The power of the Yule log gave its strength to the new born Sun when another solar year was born. Today not everyone has a fireplace in which to burn the Yule lot, but the ancient ritual can still be performed.

Small logs, particularly of birch, have been especially prepared & decorated and called Yule logs. To prepare such a log, obtain a length of natural log with the bark left on. The log will then need to be split so that it can rest on the flat side, or flattened just enough on one side to keep it from rolling. A third method is to nail two flat strips of wood to the base. Once the log is steady and secure, drill two or three 3/4 inch holes in the top of the log to receive candles. (Sometimes a florist will sell them with the holes drilled in).

Prior to your Sabbat Ritual, add the candles to the log (red or white anointed with Yule type of oil), and decorate with fresh holly, fir, pine & yew. At the appropriate point in the Ritual, light the candles and say your prayer.

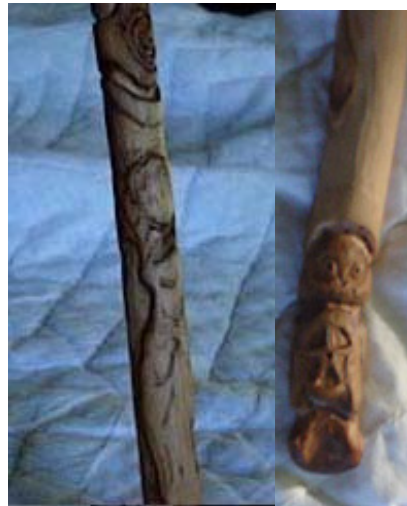
