## Runes

Waes Hael!

You know one of the things which sometimes happen with me teaching runes is that one of my students comes to me with a problem they can't solve or don't feel they are experienced enough. This week I had an ex student ask me to do a reading for a friend of hers because she wanted to make sure the reading was right. There were some major life events going on for this friend and she felt that she was too close to the person to be properly objective.

This is good practice, sometimes when we are too close to someone our knowledge of the situation can cloud our intuition and interpretation so I was happy to help out.

Ok so then this is 'Dump it all on Freyatrú' time. Which actually isn't like it sounds. When I do a reading for someone I take on the role of counselor or other care professional helping the person. I think you have to approach doing a rune cast like any other form of therapy. And if you haven't got that attitude then you shouldn't start to read for other people. So I take on a fair bit of responsibility when I do a rune cast for someone. I know that they still have the element of choice over their actions, but very often people do choose to take the advice that the runes give. Otherwise there would be no point in them seeking that advice in the first place.

Runes can unlock deep secrets from the psyche and tell you things about someone that they only barely knew themselves. So therefore when you are told that the person you are reading for is going to make life changing decisions based on what you say when you do your reading; you HAVE to approach the reading in a professional manner. Not much like the stereotypical idea of a psychic I know but all the gauze and chiffon doesn't go very well with my image as a Viking berserk warrior lol.

In actual fact the reading was very straightforward. As I often find when there are some serious issues the runes can be read quite literally from their symbolism. You do not need to read 3 books trying to find out what a particular rune in a particular position means. I teach how to use a few basic elements of symbolism for each rune and work entirely from that. This particular casting made perfect sense of the problem for the client and was what they already knew about the situation. What they needed was some re-assurance that what they thought was right. Which is the other thing about the runes: sometimes they tell us what we already know we have to do but are just hesitating from a lack of self-confidence.

There's one other thing about doing runes for someone you should maintain confidentiality and not go talking about readings you have done in such a manner that the person you are talking to is able to identify the person you did the reading for. That again is just professionalism and good practice.

So what can we glean from this about the ethics of reading runes for someone else? Firstly know your own limitations and if you don't think you will be able to do a good job for whatever reason: don't do the reading.

Secondly: If you do agree to do a reading for someone keep a professional attitude.

Thirdly: That the runes may tell you personal secrets about that person and it is your duty to maintain that person's privacy by not telling all your friends about what the cast told you.

## A - Z of Religions

### Atheism

Atheism is the absence of belief in any Gods or spiritual beings. The word Atheism comes from a, meaning without, and theism meaning belief in god or gods.

- \* The world is such a bad place that there can't be a God.

It is possible to be both atheist and religious. Virtually all Buddhists manage it, as do adherents of other religions, such as Judaism and Christianity

But many atheists are also secularist, and are hostile to any special treatment given to organised religion.

Atheists and morality

Atheists are as moral (or immoral) as religious people.

In practical terms atheists often follow the same moral code as religious people, but they arrive at the decision of what is good or bad without any help from the idea of God.

## **Who Invented Leap Year**

Leap years are years with 366 days, instead of the usual 365. Leap years are necessary because the actual length of a year is 365.242 days, not 365 days, as commonly stated. Basically, leap years occur every 4 years, and years that are evenly divisible by 4 (2004, for example) have 366 days. This extra day is added to the calendar on February 29th.

However, there is one exception to the leap year rule involving century years, like the year 1900. Since the year is slightly less than 365.25 days long, adding an extra day every 4 years results in about 3 extra days being added over a period of 400 years. For this reason, only 1 out of every 4 century years is considered as a leap year. Century years are only considered as leap years if they are evenly divisible by 400. Therefore, 1700, 1800, 1900 were not leap years, and 2100 will not be a leap year. But 1600 and 2000 were leap years, because those year numbers are evenly divisible by 400.

Julius Caesar was behind the origin of leap year in 45 BC. The early Romans had a 355 day calendar and to keep festivals occurring around the same season each year a 22 or 23 day month was created every second year. Julius Caesar decided to simplify things and added days to different months of the year to create the 365 day calendar, the actual calculation were made by Caesar's astronomer, Sosigenes. Every fourth year following the 28th day of Februarius (February 29th) one day was to be added, making every fourth year a leap year.

In 1582, Pope Gregory XIII further refined the calendar with the rule that leap day would occur in any year divisible by 4 as described above.
