Veterinary Notes – Safety and Dogs.

Following the recent reports of attacks by rottweillers in the National Press, I'll deviate from my alphabetical theme this week and discuss safety and dogs.

- Never leave a baby or child alone with a dog, however well behaved. Children can, either deliberately or inadvertently, annoy a dog to the point of retaliation, while babies and toddlers wave limbs which may prove attractive in the first instance, and the resulting yell will frighten the dog.
- Remember the cage and corner rule: dogs, even mild mannered ones will guard their bed, corner, cage against all comers. If someone attempts to enter the area the animal responds aggressively in defence of its own place. It's a common problem in veterinary practices where the dog guards its cage, but once out is all sweetness and light as is their normal nature. Children could inadvertently enter the "exclusion" zone.
- Beware the nervous biter. Many dogs will bite through fear. If you know the dog is timid, don't put it in situations where it may be frightened into biting. To a dog, children may well be frightening.
- Be considerate of the dog's feelings if its prime position in the family is usurped by a new baby. Remember to show it love and reassurance.
- Remember that a dog is a dog. Know the breed tendencies related to their original role as working dogs and by doing so know their weaknesses and so how to guard against problems. For example, terriers and collies tend to nip, hounds go wandering, rottweillers were bred to guard, greyhounds will attack and kill cats etc.
- Be aware of specific breed problems such as the, now thankfully rare, red cocker spaniel rage. When buying a puppy go to a breeder registered with the breed society, make sure you see the dam and check whether there are any temperament problems in the line. A good breeder will be honest about this as they want their puppies to go to a suitable home. Cross-bred dogs tend to be a mix of the contributing breeds.
- If taking on a rescue dog, do so only if you are prepared to accept potential behavioural problems and are able to give the dog time and love to overcome them.

A lot of behavioural advice centred on the premise that the human owner and the dog formed a pack, and the human needed to be in the alpha position. More recent research suggests that human and dog do not behave as a pack, and therefore the old advice appears both redundant and dangerous. Instead the relationship seems to be one of love and trust with the dog obeying because it wants to. You have probably seen dogs cowed into obedience, and others positively grinning with delight as they obey from love.

I personally use minimum training with my dogs. They might not be anywhere near Cruft's obedience champion level but they do what I want them to do (more or less!) but more importantly will always do what I want if it is essential, for example stopping them before they tramp over broken glass. They recognise the difference between a normal request and an urgent command. But I still would not leave them with children however soppy they might be.

The Dogmatic Atheist

Atheist good, believer bad? Lots of books on the best-seller lists would have you think so of late. But it's never as clear cut as that – especially when some atheists are becoming as shrill as the fundamentalists they decry.

FORGET children's books. Pottermania is puttering off, and they're all going to the silver screen anyway. You want to make a splash in the publishing world, just go after those silly religions and their kooky believers.

This was a banner year for atheist publishing. Just about every scientist and rationalist with a point to prove and a bank account to fill put fingers to keyboard and came out with a book slamming religion as the enemy of reason.

Anti-religious tracts have an intellectual legacy that be can traced back centuries, and Bertrand Russell's essay *Why I Am Not a Christian* is rightfully considered one of the most important documents of the 20th century.

Russell wrote from the ethics point of view, of how so much religious belief seems muddled by superstition, and of how blind obedience has done so much social harm.

Indeed, the first few atheists I met when I was a young lad had a clear moral purpose that I could not help but admire. Their outlook was not dictated by what was “writ from above,” but doing the right thing for its own sake.

Perhaps it was because it was the 1980s, and they were enjoying the residual effects of the previous decade's Hippie movement – you know, all that stuff that people today seem to feel embarrassed about, such as love and peace for your fellow Man, respect for Mother Earth, making love not war, etc.

My, but how atheism (from the Greek *atheos*, or godless) has changed over the intervening years. If you surf the Net for atheist websites today, you get some that argue for atheism in a logical and consistent manner. But you also get many that shrilly attack religions and people of faith for being stupid and superstitious.

This is militant atheism or antitheism, people who actively oppose religions and those who believe in them, as opposed to people who just don't believe in any supernatural or divine force.

The lines are sometimes blurred between the two, but it does seem that the new breed is on the rise, exacerbated by the Internet's ability to bring people of similar ilk together, for better or worse. Buoyed by their self-referential loop (“Others think like me, so I must be right!”), they've been gaining force and voice.

The commercial success of recent books such as Richard Dawkins' *The God Delusion* and Christopher Hitchens' *God is Not Great: How Religion Poisons Everything* has become a rallying point. Now everybody with delusions of scholastic aptitude and writing ability thinks he or she can be published too. Expect to see a flood of such works in 2008, and keep in mind (Theodore) Sturgeon's Law: 90% of everything is crap.

Dawkins, an evolutionary biologist, coined the term “meme” for the unit of cultural information that seems to propagate across society, much in the same way a gene does with biological information. Religion is a kind of meme, he argued in his groundbreaking 1976 book, *The Selfish Gene*.

Well, so is atheism, ironically.

The new breed of atheist writers will present the same tired old arguments, again and again. They will pick the same easy targets – the Catholic Church's chequered past, the Crusades, the Inquisition, the most repressive of Islamic states, fundamentalist-driven (or rationalised, rather) terrorism, priests' sexual abuse of choirboys, those silly televangelists, and, of course, George W. Bush getting his orders to invade another country from his conversations with God.

Guardian Online blogger Theo Hobson put it best: “I consider the atheist's desire to generalise about religion to be a case of intellectual cowardice. The intellectual coward is one who chooses simplicity over complexity and difficulty. The militant atheist chooses to uphold a worldview of Animal Farm crudity: atheist good, believer bad. He has to believe this; it is his claim to the moral high ground.”

These new atheists will ignore the everyday stories that don't get told because they don't make for good copy – the village priest who takes care of his flock, the friend who's always there for you, the people who have dedicated themselves to serving at charitable organisations and children's homes ... the unsung heroes and folk who live their quiet lives doing good.

They'll just refuse to look at how religion can be a force for good. They will also ignore the acts of famous atheists like Josef Stalin and Mao Zedong, and the atrocities committed throughout the years by revolutionaries and rebels fighting against religious and other types of institutions.

Author and journalist Hitchens writes that religion is “violent, irrational, intolerant, allied to racism and tribalism and bigotry, invested in ignorance and hostile to free inquiry, contemptuous of women and coercive toward children.”

Can't imagine why someone would describe Wiccans as being “contemptuous of women”. (Wicca is a religion many describe as witchcraft and its followers are considered to be very women-centric.)

It's obvious that some antitheists are just as blinkered as the religious types they decry, or have built their views on all religions based merely on the one or two they've been exposed to.

They just have to paint everything with as broad a paintbrush as they can. The devil is in the nuances, as they say.

So they will use the Creationists and Intelligent Design proponents as examples of why religion is the enemy of science, but ignore the fact the fully half of American scientists have said they believe in something and have no problems reconciling their religious values and scientific views.

And they will explore many areas, but will steer clear of this simple truth: That the belief in “something other,” stemming from our need to make sense of the complex and confusing world around us, seems to be a universal value. It's much like love for one's children, cutting across every culture, race and religion.

In fact, they will pursue their agenda with the same passionate intensity as the proselytisers they criticise, and with a dogmatic resistance to looking at any fact or truth that may weaken their position.
