Enquire Within for Everything (Well Almost!)

Merry Meet Everyone!

Well the Weather Man got it a tad wrong (as usual ☺) and instead of a little rain and frosts on the ranges we have had sleet and snow and the frost and ice is so thick it looks like snow on the ground.

Temperatures of 4-6 deg C here in Brisbane are rare occurrences.. Well I did tell the birds they were a bit out of timing. lol.

However the sun is shining and the sky is blue today so thank you to the Mother of us all for mercies small and large.

Today I checked out my stores of ointments and plasters, not that I make many of these anymore. However I do like to use a good ginger, cayenne, fennel and rosemary blend in a plaster or as a rub. I find I am going through the arthritis remedies a bit faster than I would like. I enjoy the cold but not the joint pain.

So on the list goes these ointments and a note to plant some extra fennel and sage, and put aside extra dried rosemary for teas as well. Another reason to make sure I have plenty of mustard in the cupboard too for foot baths.

As I am dealing with Osteo-Arthritis I will also make sure I have a new supply of *Joint-food in the medicine cabinet as well.

If you have inflamed joints there is always the cabbage or sage poultice to use in desperation ☺. The sage is not so bad but I am not so keen on the cabbage.

Whilst I think about it the other cold weather complaint we seem to suffer more of as we get more mature ☺, is Irritable Bladder. Keep a good supply of barley and corn silk on hand if this is a problem for you and make a tea or a cordial of one or both of them and drink plenty of them.

Making Plasters:

Firstly what is a plaster (sometimes spelt plaister) and what do we use it for?

The Macquarie Dictionary tells me that a plaster (in this usage) is an adhesive bandage or it means to overspread with anything thickly.

This is as good a description as any of what a plaster is (though I refrain from using an adhesive bandage☺).

A plaster is a bandage made from clean, fine cotton, spread thickly with an ointment or cream that you wish to treat an area of the body with. This is then wrapped firmly around the limb or joint you wish to treat and is held in place by an elastic bandage.

Very useful for getting heating and soothing herbs into an arthritic joint.

So I have in my description virtually told you how to make them.

Ingredients required:

- Clean fresh fine cotton (old sheets washed in hot water and dried in the sun make excellent bandages).
- Ointment of choice.
- An elastic or crepe bandage to hold the plaster in place.

Method:

- Cut strips of cotton into lengths long enough to cover the joint area completely twice.
- Warm the ointment by standing the jar in a bowl of hot water.
- Spread the ointment onto the bandage while it is still molten, leaving a margin down the sides of the bandage.
- Lay the bandage on a sheet of plastic cling film slightly longer than it in length and wide enough to overlap on both sides.
- Fold the plastic wrap over the bandage at the top then roll up (not too tightly) twist the sides (tails) to seal the wrap.
- Store in a clean dry lidded container such as a tin or plastic freezer container.
- Label and Store in a cool dry place.

Usage:

- Bring a saucepan of water to the boil, turn off the heat.
- Put the roll in a colander or steamer and place on the saucepan.
- Heat the plaster gently until soft and pliable.
- Remove from the heat and remove the bandage from the plastic wrap.
- Wrap around the limb or joint whilst still warm.
- Cover with crepe or elastic bandage and leave for at least one to two days. Replace as is necessary.

Making Ointments.

I have two ways to make ointments, one uses oils and the other uses powdered herbs.

I have given a recipe for ointment in an earlier article but no matter.

First we need to determine what our ointment is for and decide on the herbs we will use. These days I only use beeswax to thicken ointments or coconut oil or cocoa butter when I want a cream that will melt into the skin.

The basic ointment recipe

- Ingredients:
 - 300ml (11/4 cups) herbal infused oil 25g (1oz) Beeswax

If you want to make a larger quantity the ratio of oil to wax is **10:1**

Sweet Almond and Sunflower are both good oils to use (do not use a mineral oil).

Infuse fresh herbs in the oil and leave in sunlight for at least 3 weeks before making up the ointment. Or see next issue for how to make your own infused oils faster, in the kitchen.

- Place the oil in a heatproof glass jug and add the wax

- Stand the jug in a large saucepan, and fill saucepan to just below the level of oil in the jug with water.
- Bring the water to a gentle boil and turn down heat.
- Simmer until the beeswax melts stirring occasionally (use a metal spoon)
- Remove the jug and allow the oil/wax blend to cool slightly.
- Pour into sterilized screw top jars to about 1cm (½ inch) from the top of the jar.
- Leave open until fully set.
- The ointment will set with a small hollow in the centre, gently re-melt any left over ointment and top up the jars to create a smooth surface.

The type of herb used when making the infused oil determines the use you will put this ointment to.

This recipe can also be used to create a natural perfume.

Use perfumed flowers to infuse the oil or add your favourite essential oils to make your own blend. Add Myrrh resin to increase the staying power of the perfume.

A quick method:

Ingredients:

- Take 150ml (2/3 cup) Almond or Sunflower oil (always use cold pressed oils)
- 15g (1/2 oz) Beeswax
- 50g (2oz) very finely ground herb of choice
- Or 25g (1oz) very finely ground spice of choice

Method:

- Place the beeswax, oil and chosen powdered herb or spice into a bowl or pan with a lid on.
- Place the bowl in a pan of water, bring water to the boil
- Turn down heat and simmer for an hour
- Take out of hot water, stand in a pan of cold water, remove the lid and cool, stirring constantly to keep powdered herbs suspended in the wax/oil mix.
- Pour into jars when sufficiently cooled, let cool completely, label, date and store in a cool dry place.

RUNES

Waes Hael!

This week I am going to do the obvious thing and give a Heathen and runic take on Lughnassadh. Which is going to be interesting because I have not found any evidence from ancient literature that Lughnassadh was celebrated in any of the Heathen countries.

In fact the current wheel of eight festivals is a modern invention made by combining several different ancient festival calendars. Heathens only celebrated two festivals for certain with another three possible.

The two definite first. Winter finding and Summer finding. Yule and Litha. You may think that Walpurgisnacht sounds very Heathen but in actual fact has its origins in the late middle ages and so is far too late to be considered an original festival.

There is another festival that is authentic however, called Disirblot. This was held around the time that we celebrate Imbolc today, though the themes of the festivals are different. It may just be coincidence that two cultures both have festivals at the same time.

The two speculative festivals are Eostre named after a Saxon Goddess and Samhain which was a time of slaughter and sacrifice in preparation for winter. I think it entirely likely that the Heathens of the past would not have wasted all that blood but would have used at least some of it to redden their altars. Especially in Iceland the Heathens had to have an entirely practical way of living due to the harsh climate. I know I have skipped rather quickly through these and not gone into much depth but it is after all Lughnassadh which is coming not Yule or Beltaine.

It is Lughnassadh that I have had to write a Heathen ritual for. A festival which comes from the Celtic calendar not the Norse one. So how do I find things within Heathenry to fit into a festival which falls outside of the Heathen tradition?

The Eddas is the first place I look when I start to research anything. There are two contenders, One Aesir and one Vanir.

Thor was historically invoked for the protection of crops. He was seen as a protector of the common people and the fact he had control over thunder storms makes him an ideal God to pray to if you want good weather for your crops to ripen.

Frey on the other hand I have a very good passage from the Prose Edda.

Frey is an exceedingly famous God; he decides when the sun shall shine or the rain come down, and along with that the fruitfulness of the Earth, and he is good to invoke for peace and plenty.

(Taken from 'The Deluding of Gylfi' Translated by Jean I Young)

So you can see that I would have had a good basis for using Frey as the central theme for the ritual. I chose Thor in the end because I wanted a sense of balance in the ritual. Thor has a wife

named Sif, whose hair is cut by Loki. This is seen as a parallel for the corn being cut. Through various attempts and ticks Loki manages to get replacement hair spun from Gold, a spear for Odin named Gungnir, Frey's ship Skidbladnir, and also a boar which could run over sea or land faster than any horse and Thor's Hammer; Mjolnir.

This can be seen as a sacrifice myth. You have to make a sacrifice of some of the wheat in order that you have seeds to sow for next year. If you eat it all and don't save any then you will starve.

The ritual I ended up writing is a symbiosis of Heathenry and Witchcraft. For instance I only invoke North and South represented by fire and Ice. These in turn represent the lands of Muspelheim and Niflheim.

For the man focus however I am using the old folk tradition of leaving the last sheaf of wheat standing in the field as an offering to Slipeknir who is Odin's 8-legged horse. Since he is able to travel between all 9 realms, asking Slipeknir to carry your prayers to the Gods seems like quite a good idea. It also uses the common harvest theme of Lughnassadh from the more general pagan movement combining them with a knot spell to tie the sheaf together.

Next week I will let you know if it was a success or not!

A-Z of Dragons

VASUKI

Origin: India

Also known as Naga. Characterised by a snake-body, human head, and the ability to change between the two. They are wingless. They are not considered to be particularly dangerous in general, although some believe they are destined to destroy the world with fire. May live in the underwater kingdom of Patala in the city of Bhogavati and are patrons of the clouds and water, and worshipped for fertility in southern India. Could make men invisible under the waves and would give the favoured drink, soma, to make them strong. Nagas could understand birds and would give charms to the humans so that they, too, could understand. "In European and Arabian stories, folk heroes acquire the language of birds, or of all animals, after eating the hearts of dragons. A Naga king causes an Indian king to understand what animals say.

Some sources claim there are exactly 1000 of them, and their king was Ananta-Shesha with between 7 and 1000 heads. Others say the King's name was Bhuridatta, who became Buddha.

VISHAP

Origin: Armenia

Vishap was a fearsome and terrifying dragon from the legends of Armenia and was said to inhabit the top of Mount Ararat. Many warriors sought to kill this dragon due to the legend that its blood would render any weapon it touched so poisonous that the slightest wound would be fatal.

VELES

Origin: Russia

Veles, god of cattle, stole the cattle of Perun who chased him. Veles would turn himself into animals and objects to hide but was always found and destroyed. Veles sometimes took on dragon or serpent form.

VRITRA

Origin: India

Vritra is the name of the giant serpent, or dragon, from Hindu mythology. Vritra's name means 'encloser' or 'enveloper' and he is sometimes pictured as a three-headed serpent that encircles the whole world. As the destructive element of nature, Vritra caused a major drought by drinking all the earth's waters. The god Indra battled against him but Vritra gained the upper hand for a while by swallowing the thunder-god. Indra was saved, however, when the other gods gagged Vritra, allowing Indra to escape. He then slew Vritra as it coiled around the mountains, and cut open its body with his thunderbolts, releasing the world's waters once more.

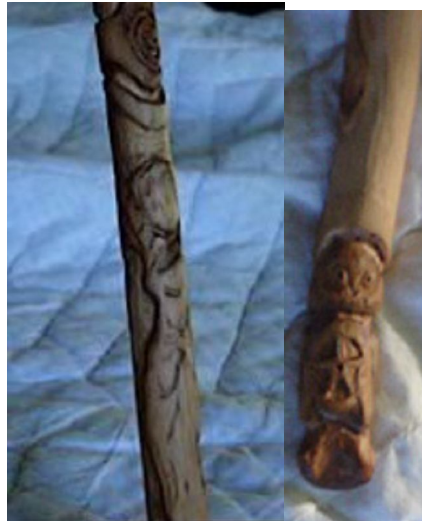
