Veterinary Notes A is for Abscess

An abscess forms when the body's defences form a barrier around a point of infection such as a bite or a stake wound. This effectively keeps the invading bacteria from accessing the rest of the body and prevents a systemic infection. The white blood cells attack the bacteria in a number of different ways, either by producing antibodies which latch onto proteins on the surface of bacteria, or by engulfing ("eating") the bacteria. The pus within the abscess is a mixture of dead white blood cells and bacteria. The volume of pus increases as more bacteria are killed, increasing the pressure in the abscess and hence the level of pain. This latter is relieved when the abscess bursts, discharging its contents. In some cases, the defences of the body are insufficient and a potentially fatal systemic bacteraemia (bacteria in the blood) may ensue. Another complication occurs when the walled off bacteria in the abscess secrete toxins into the blood resulting in a toxæmia which may also be fatal.

The most common type of abscess arises from cat bites to other cats. Unneutered tom cats are at greatest risk of fight-wounds, but these may occur in other cats particularly when a new animal moves into the neighbourhood. Bites are one of the commonest causes of pain and malaise in a cat, but other causes such as road traffic injuries or more severe systemic illnesses must be excluded by a veterinary surgeon. It is very important not to take risks with your animal's health.

Some of you may have experience of taking your cat to the vet when it is showing these non-specific signs, only to have the vet run his/her hands over the cat and declare within a few seconds that it is a cat bite infection. The vet is feeling for any matted patches of hair or scabs that are hidden in the fur, both clear signs of a bite. This is confirmed by parting the hair and seeing the marks of the two incisors about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch apart. This sensitivity of touch has been honed over long years of practice and is a valuable skill. Although you probably will not have access to the number of animals and range of conditions that allowed your vet to gain experience, you can develop this skill to a lesser degree by regularly feeling all over your animal (try keeping your eyes shut to enhance the sense of touch) and noting any bumps and lumps that shouldn't be there.

A cat with fight wounds is often off its food, hiding away in corners, moving stiffly, hissing when touched, and generally out of character. Such signs could also be attributed to road accidents, falls from trees (they can fall and don't always land on their feet), stake wounds (where they jump down onto a pointed object) or airgun injuries, so an accurate diagnosis is essential. When the bite wound is identified, the vet will usually remove the scab to allow drainage of the pus. Large abscesses will need to be lanced or excised under general anaesthetic, smaller abscesses may be managed by the owner bathing the wound with warm salty water several times daily to ensure that drainage continues. In all cases, the cat will be given antibiotics to prevent a systemic infection or toxæmia. These will either be a long-acting injection or tablets. The latter tend to be more effective but the former is better for owners who have trouble giving pills. Recovery after treatment is usually uneventful.

When giving tablets to your cat, be determined to succeed and don't hesitate. Remember that cats hate losing a battle, and if they know you will win they will submit and pretend they actually want the pill. Be gentle but firm, the cat needs to feel secure in your arms. Talk to your cat and reassure it. Holding the head by the body ridges below the eyes tilt the head back gently till the cat is looking at the ceiling. In this position, the mouth begins to open automatically. Do not have your fingers all over the throat where they will obstruct breathing and cause panic. Holding the tablet between index finger and thumb, use the middle finger to pull down the lower jaw positioning the finger between the lower incisors. Pop the pill in, keep the head up and hold the mouth closed until the cat swallows. You can also reopen the mouth and check the pill has gone, and give it another poke if it hasn't. Remember that each success in giving pills will make all subsequent attempts much easier. As your cat's owner, carer and source of comfort you have an enormous advantage over strangers when it comes to pill giving. The cat already trusts you and they really do know when someone is trying to help them.

A–Z of Religions: Ifa: the religion of the Yoruba peoples

Yoruba refers to a group of cultures linked by a common language. They occupied an area bounded by the Niger River, and including what is now known as the Benin Republic, southwestern Nigeria, and part of Togo. They held a belief system in common: the Ifa religion.

Starting in the 16th century, large numbers of Yoruba natives were transported as slaves to the Caribbean and the Americas. They combined beliefs and practices from their Ifa religion with elements of Roman Catholicism to produce the syncretistic religions of Candomblé, Palo Mayombe, Santeria, Vodun, etc. These are now flourishing in the Caribbean, South America and North America, notably in Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Grenada, the Guyanas, Jamaica, Puerto Rico, St. Kitts, St. Vincent, Tobago, and Trinidad.

Information on the Internet can be found using such search phrases as: Yoruba faith, Orisha worship, and Ifa religion. Searching for "Ifa" will not be productive because so many organizations have IFA as their acronym.

The original religions of Africa have been declining over the past century due to the influences of colonialism, Western acculturation and proselytizing by Christianity and Islam. However, in the Americas and Caribbean, syncretistic religions involving African religions are growing rapidly.

Beliefs:

Deities and other supernatural forces: Followers of Ifa believe in: Olodumare or Olorun as the supreme deity. According to author Bolasi E. Idowu:

"He is supreme over all on earth and in heaven, acknowledged by all the divinities as the Head to whom all authority belongs and all allegiance is due. . . His status of supremacy is absolute. Things happen when He approves, things do not come to pass if He disapproves. In worship, the Yoruba holds Him ultimately First and Last; in man's daily life, He has the ultimate pre-eminence."

He is also referred to as: Oluwa (Lord), Eleda (Creator), Olofin-Orun (King of heaven), Orise (the source of all things) and Oba-Orun (The king who dwells in the heavens).²

Orisha (a.k.a. Orisa; literally "head guardians"), who are considered as ministers of Olodumare and intermediaries between Olodumare and humanity. Estimates of their number range from 201 to 1,700. These correspond to the Orisha in Santeri and Orixá in Candomblé. They include: Esu, an trickster deity who generates confusion but is also a protector.

Ibeji, the deity of twins.

Ogun, the god of iron, war, justice, and the chase.

Orisa-nla, a senior Orisha who created the Earth and humanity.

Orunmila, the oracle divinity.

Osanyin, the god of magic and medicine.

Osun, the goddess of the river Osun

Oya, the goddess of the river Niger.

Sango, the god of thunder and lightning.

Sopona, the divinity associated with smallpox.

Yemoja, the goddess of all rivers.

Spirits, psychic agencies, or forces of nature. They are often associated with trees, rocks, rivers, forests, hills, etc.

Ancestors from previous generations who have died, become spirits and yet who retain an interest in their families. They can "... influence living members of the family for good or evil, but their influence does not extend beyond their specific families. In short, they act as intermediaries between their living descendants and the orisa or Olorun."

Creation story: New Orleans Mystic writes:

"There are many variations on the story of creation and how the Orisha were born from the coupling of Oduduwa and Omonide (Obatala and Yemaya). An example is given in this excerpt from Dr. Marta Maria Vega's "Altar of My Soul:"

"The Orisha Olodumare, the Supreme God, originally lived in the lower part of heaven, overlooking endless stretches of water. One day, Olodumare decided to create Earth, and sent an emissary, the orisha Obatalá, to perform this task. Olodumare gave Obatalá the materials he needed to create the world: a small bag of loose earth, a gold chain, and a five-toed hen."

"Obatalá was instructed to use the chain to descend from heaven. When he reached the last link, he piled the loose earth on top of the water. Next, he placed the hen on the pile of earth, and ordered her to scatter the earth with her toes across the surface of the water."

"When this was finished, Obatalá climbed the chain to heaven to report his success to Olodumare. Olodumare then sent his trusted assistant, the chameleon, to verify that the earth was dry. When his helper had assured him that the Earth was solid, Olodumare named Earth 'Ile Ife,' the sacred house."

"Before he retired to the uppermost level of heaven, Olodumare decided to distribute his sacred powers 'aché.' He united Obatalá, the Orisha of creation, and Yemayá, the orisha of the ocean, who gave birth to a pantheon of orishas, each possessing a share of Olodumare's sacred power. At last, the divine power of Olodumare was dispersed. Then one day, Olodumare called them all from Earth to heaven and gave Obatalá the sacred power to create human life. Obatalá returned to Earth and created our ancestors, endowing them with his own divine power. We are all descendants from the first people of the sacred city of Ile Ife; we are all children of Olodumare, the sacred orisha who created the world."

Belief in magic:

Oogun, egbogi and isegun refer to magic. When magic is used to cure or prevent disease, it is called medicine. Attempts to protect a person from sorcery, improve their financial situation, bringing good luck, etc. are referred to as magic.

Belief in witchcraft:

Aje, eye and osonga refer to witchcraft. This is typically performed by female witches who are believed to harm people or property through the use of their psychic power.

Belief in sorcery:

Oso, oogun ika or oogun buburu refer to sorcery or bad magic. These involve attempts to harm or kill persons or destroy their property through the use of negative rituals.

Origin: Ethiopia

Once four of them were reported to have woven themselves into a raft and sailed over the Red Sea to Arabia, where there were better places to hunt.

FAFNIR

Origin: Norse Mythology

Sigurd (also known as Siegfried) Volsung was told by the dwarf Regin to gain fame and power to slay a terrible dragon named Fafnir that guarded a huge mound of treasure.

Sigurd took up interest in this dragon, and was awarded with his father's broken sword (named Gram) which Regin forged back into one whole massive sword. Sigurd and the dwarf rode to find the fearless beast. What Sigurd did not know is that Regin's brother murdered their father to gain the wealth of the kingdom. This brother's name was Fafnir. Fafnir, because of his greed for gold and jewels changed his corrupt self into a massive dragon to protect his hoard better.

From what Sigurd knew of dragons, their tough, scaly hide on the top of the body was impregnable to any weapon. Regin suggested building a pit in which Sigurd could hide. So they both dug a pit outside of the dragon's lair. With Sigurd hiding, Regin covered the pit with branches. The 9 Herbs Charm (according to Janet and Stewart Farrar and Gavin Bone) con't..

Stanzas 3, 4 and 5

This herb is called **Stigme**, it grew upon a stone,
It resists poison, it fights pain. It is called harsh, it fights against poison.
This is the herb that strove against the snake;
This has strength against poison, this has strength against infection
This has strength against the foe who fares throughout the land.

Now, **Cocks–spur grass**, conquer the greater poisons,
Though thou art the lesser.
Thou, the mightier, vanquish the lesser,
Until he is cured of both

Remember, **Mayweed**, what thou didst reveal,
What thou did bring to pass at Alorford;
That he never yielded his life because of infection,
After Mayweed was dressed for his food.

Here we have three herbs common in their day being used for poison (toxins afflicting the patients as well as venom) antidotes, anti – septic and bacteriosides.

Stigme, one would have hoped that Culpepper found this a fascinating herb, he however did not mention it by this name.

After considerable time spent researching on the net I came up with two possibilities:
An extremely rare Fungi named *Stigme lussoniensis*, found in Sth America..
Is it one of the many lichens called Liverwort.

Or; What if the stanza had been translated incorrectly and we are on what is commonly termed “a Wild Goose-Chase”.

Thank the powers that be for Google, for whilst searching for Mayweed I stumbled across the website www.cauldronfarm.com and thanks also to Raven Cauldera for her wonderful rendition of The Nine Herbs Charm, for it suddenly all made sense..

What The Farrars and Gavin Bone called *Stigme* was actually **Stume** or **Watercress** as we know it.

The herb that strove against the snake is **Viper’s Bugloss** not Cockspur Grass, a herb well known in Europe and North America.

And so... **Stume** (Watercress (*Nasturtium officinale*)) also called Scurvy grass;
As listed by Mrs Grieves in *A Modern Herbal*, Watercress is an antiscorbutic, an appetite promoter and skin lotion for blotches, spots and Blemishes. It was used also as a specific remedy for Tuberculosis.

It is rich in Vitamin C and iron, excellent tonic. Fresh plant is an appetite stimulant. Used for catarrh and bronchitis; make cough syrup from watercress and honey. Aids in eliminating retained fluid. Culpeper advises the bruised leaves to be placed directly on the skin to combat freckles, pimples and other skin ailments. Watercress is an excellent diuretic, but large doses are purgative. Leaves are edible and mustard- flavored.

Next came the snake venom fighter; Viper's Bugloss.

Viper's Bugloss (*Echium vulgare*);

Keeps away snakes. Culpeper's Complete Herbal describes Viper's Bugloss as follows: "It is a most gallant herb of the Sun; it is a pity it is not more in use than it is. It is an especial remedy against the biting of the Viper, and all other venomous beasts, or serpents; as also against poison, or poisonous herbs". Discorides and others say, "That whosoever shall take of the herb or root before they be bitten, they shall not be hurt by the poison of any serpent."

Uses:

Breaks fevers, diuretic, expectorant, use for pain from inflammations. Used for snakebite. Seeds were decocted and mixed in wine "to comfort the heart and drive away melancholy"; i.e. as an antidepressant.

And then the innocent Mayweed or Chamomile;

Chamomile (*Matricaria recutita*)

Known by many other names including:

Baldersbrow, Maegthen, Maythen, **Mayweed**, Ground Apple, Heermanschen, Manzanilla, Chamaimylon, Whig Plant, German Chamomile.

Sedative, antifungal, antimicrobial, antispasmodic, anti-inflammatory. Relieves gas, heartburn and colic. Applied externally in teabags to heal burns and rest eyes. Ointment is used for eczema, and genital and anal irritation. Mouthwash heals mouth inflammation. Inhalation of steam is good for phlegm and hay fever. Chamomile is the safest possible herb for children, easing the pain of colic when a mild tea is mixed with mother's milk and giving them rest without the aid of allopathic drugs.

It is possible for some people however to get an allergic reaction Chamomile. So care is required.

Thus far we have: Mugwort

Plantain

Watercress

Viper's Bugloss

Chamomile

All bar one I know well, and it is my intention to do some more research on Viper's Bugloss as soon as I am able, to find out if it is in fact not grown in Australia.

And so we come to the end of today's article.
