Mulled Cider with Spices

4-5 cups apple cider

3-4 cloves

2 sticks cinnamon

1 allspice

1 lemon with peel sliced thin

1 orange with peel sliced thin

1 apple sliced into 1/4 by 1 by 1 inch pieces

In a large saucepan, heat cider and spices, but do not boil. Serve in a large cauldron.

Samhain Oil and Incense

Protection Oil

1 dram olive oil

1 dram Patchouli oil

1 tsp. broken pieces of Mandrake Root

1 dram Cinnamon Oil

3 heaping tsp. coarse sea salt ground very fine

1 dram Myrrh Oil

In a clean metal bowl, mix the olive oil, sea salt, and mandrake root. Mix thoroughly with a wooden spoon. Transfer the mixture to a clean sterilized jar. Using a dropper, add the essential oils. Swirl the essential oils into the base oil/salt/mandrake mixture, don't stir. Gently rotate the oil clockwise. Store the oil away from heat, light and moisture in an airtight glass bottle.

Incenses

#1

Nettle, Calendula, patchouli leaves, myrrh, Bay Leaf

Oak Leaf, Tarragon, 2 drops Cinnamon Oil, Sage

Place ingredients in a bowl. The Cinnamon Oil is a resin used to bond the ingredients and retain scent. Burn in a safe dish or other burner on an instant light charcoal briquette.

1 Part Powdered Allspice, 1 Part Ground Black Pepper

2 Parts Clove Powder, 1 Part Myrrh (small resin chunks)

12 Parts lightly crushed Rose Petals

Runes

This week I was asked to write something about the recent Lustration of the Ancestors held at Sedna Temple in Suffolk England. So here are my thoughts and feelings about the Lustration which evolved and changed over the course of the weekend.

I arrived in Suffolk as the only outer court member who attended the weekend. My path is that of Heathenry. My Goddess Freya calls me; and I have long since given up attempting to resist. Well perhaps a bit now and again, till the idea that she is actually right starts to sink in. In all I am a stubborn somewhat cantankerous individual who very much believes in following my own path as defined by me, and no one else.

The first thing, which I have found on line as well as meeting people in real life, is the welcome that I get from Correllians. Even though I have always maintained that my first path is elsewhere. As regular readers will know, I teach runes through a Sedna sponsored study group. So it was with a little apprehension that I brought with me materials for a talk and a workshop on runes. I especially looked forward to seeing what Lord Don's reaction would be to the lecture.

As there had been a few people drop out at the last minute it happened that mine was the only workshop. Unfortunately due to some time zone confusions Lord Don, Lady Krystel and Lady Debbe did not arrive till just after I had finished the lecture so I never did get to hear what they thought of it! I had favourable comments from the people who did attend though and I can only hope that their understanding of the runes as a system of magic has been expanded and enriched.

On the Saturday there was first deeming of temples. I had planned to use the time to catch up on some reading, I am working my way through the Norse Sagas at the minute and have fallen behind somewhat. However due to some non-attendees they were short of a herald. This was a role I was happy to fill even though I had absolutely no idea what it entailed when I volunteered!

Then one of those strange things happened that fate puts you in the right time at the right place to be able to make something happen. Lord Don was handing out ritual parts and asked me if I was ok with casting the circle. I think my reply was along the lines of: 'I am fine with it, but I suspect the way I cast a circle and the way you cast a circle are a little different.' Which was when I got the opportunity to perform a Heathen hammer working to open a Correllian ritual. I am not going to explain what that is here and now. Partly because I have written about it in a past issue; partly because it will soon be available to watch on video and you will get a much better idea from seeing me do it, than from me telling you. If I thought that was going to be the end of my involvement then I was to have that thought banished forever that afternoon.

It seemed that owing to there being four people for initiation there was a need for someone to act as a Paladin and watch over the initiates while they were meditating and to bring them into the ritual room. One of the questions I was asked first was whether I wanted to be initiated. I suppose I should have been expecting the question but it did catch me off guard. Even though I know my mentor would support my application to clergy 110% I have not passed all the required courses yet and still have some of the coursework to do. So it had not even entered my head that I would be initiated. Throughout the weekend I proudly wore the lavender stole of a priest of another tradition which was another reason I had not considered initiation into the clergy. Freya Herself has accepted me as her Gothi (priest) and I didn't and still don't think that any membership of any human organised path is going to supersede that. Still you can never tell what the future might hold for you especially when you have Freya prodding you in various directions. So my reply was 'not at this time.'

I must have done a good job so far because after dinner that evening I was asked to take two parts in the Lustration ritual the next day: those of Vocifer and Guardian. Perhaps, I think owing to me having the loudest mouth and the biggest sword! Maybe also due to there being several people present who had never attended a live ritual before. I belong to a local hearth and have a fair amount of experience both in taking parts in rituals others have written; and leading those I have written myself. We all had to take several parts as there were only nine of us for the ritual; so I thing necessity had a fair amount to do with it as well. It was during this thrashing out of who was to take what part that I realised that we do exactly the same before a ritual in my hearth. I realised that the ritual was going to be nothing that I hadn't already dealt with in other rituals. So I relaxed and from then on could simply enjoy being with people who were friends and fellow travellers with me down this part of my path. Though in the end the Lustration did hold at least one surprise for me.

As Guardian it was my job to cleanse the circle and banish and negative energy before the rest of the people entered. (You will be able to see the video of this as well soon so I will let that speak for itself.) What the video will not show you is the link between all the people present. I think that because there were only nine of us instead of the more usual 50 at a Lustration that there was far more of a personal connection between us all.

There may only have been nine but nine is a good number. There are nine worlds in Norse mythology; Odin hung himself on Yggdrasil for nine days, and there were nine members of the Fellowship of the Ring! (I guess that makes Lord Don Gandalf and me Aragorn then)

Nine people created such energy between them. I have worked with many people in circle before. Some I would not want to work with again. I would stand next to any of those eight in a circle again in troth and with joy.

Oh yes, the surprise that the Lustration had for me? Being awarded the order of the Golden Wands.

I must just mention one last thing that I gained from the weekend. Because there were only a few of us I managed to have several conversations with both Lord Don and in particular Lady Krystel. As a result of these I think I would revise my answer to whether I want to be initiated into the Correllian clergy. I think now my answer would be: 'Not yet, but soon.'

A – Z of Religions – Unitarianism

There are about 7,000 Unitarians in Great Britain and Ireland, and about 150 Unitarian ministers. There are about 800,000 Unitarians worldwide.

Unitarianism is an open-minded and individualistic approach to religion that gives scope for a very wide range of beliefs and doubts.

Religious freedom for each individual is at the heart of Unitarianism. Everyone is free to search for meaning in life in a responsible way and to reach their own conclusions.

In line with their approach to religious truth, Unitarians see diversity and pluralism as valuable rather than threatening. They want religion to be broad, inclusive, and tolerant. Unitarianism can therefore include people who are Christian, Jewish, Buddhist, Pagan and Atheist.

- * Unitarianism has no standard set of beliefs
- * Unitarians believe that religious truth is not necessarily or primarily laid down either in scriptures, by a holy person or by a religious institution
 - o no individual or group in Unitarianism makes an exclusive claim to the truth
 - o within certain core values each Unitarian can believe what they feel is right
- * Unitarians are so called because they insist on the oneness of God and because they affirm the essential unity of humankind and of creation
- * Unitarians believe religion should make a difference to the world, so they are often active in social justice and community work
- * Unitarianism grew out of the Protestant Reformation of the 16th century CE and started in Poland and Transylvania in the 1560s
- * Unitarians have adopted the Flaming Chalice as the symbol of their faith
- * The Unitarians were the first church in Britain to accept women as ministers, in 1904
- * Unitarians welcome gays and lesbians in their ministry and support equal rights for gay people within the Church and in society at large

A heretical religion?

Early Unitarians felt that the language of the Bible spoke clearly of "one God". Because of this they felt that the traditional Christian idea of God being a Trinity was wrong.

From the viewpoint of mainstream Christianity, therefore, Unitarianism is a heretical belief, and for many centuries those who believed in the unity of God were persecuted by the churches.
