Pagan Calendar January 24 – 30

January 24. Ekeko, the Aymara Indian pot-bellied god of prosperity, is honored on this date with an annual fair called the Alacitas, which is held in La Paz, Bolivia.

In Hungary, a Pagan purification known as the Blessing of the Candle of the Happy Women is performed annually on this date.

January 25. Good-luck rituals are traditionally performed during the Vietnamese Lunar New Year Festival (Tet), which takes place annually on or around this date. Offerings are made to ancient deities and ancestors, traditional feasts are prepared, and evil spirits are driven away with whistles, bells, and horns.

January 26. Each year on the second new moon after the winter solstice (which normally occurs on or around this time of the month), the traditional Chinese New Year begins and is celebrated for two consecutive weeks until the full moon.

On the first day of the New Year, ancestral spirits are honored and houses are decorated with strips of red paper to attract good luck and ward off evil ghosts. A Lantern Festival and Dragon Parade traditionally take place on the last night of the New Year celebration.

January 27. On this date, the annual Day of Ishtar ceremony takes place to honor the ancient Assyrian/Babylonian goddess of love, fertility, and battle. Ishtar is identified with the ancient Phoenician goddess called Astarte.

January 28. In the Shetland Islands, a centuries-old fire festival known as Up-Helly-Aa is held each year on the last Tuesday of January (which normally falls around this date). The festival, which marks the end of the traditional Yuletide and pays tribute to the old gods and goddesses of the ancient Viking religion, climaxes with the torching of a replica of a Viking ship. The day ends with a traditional prayer to drive away evil entities from village homes.

January 29. On this day in the year 1688, famous mystic, scientist, and spiritualist-medium Emanuel Swedenborg was born in Sweden. His works had a major influence upon the secret societies of the eighteenth century, and a religion based on his mystical theological philosophy was founded in his name by his followers.

In the country of Vietnam, a mythical and centuries-old Parade of the Unicorns takes place each year on this date (approximately).

According to mythology, the ancient Pagan goddesses Irene and Pax were born on this day.

January 30. In ancient Rome, an agricultural festival called the Feriae Sementiva (Feast of Spring) was celebrated annually on this date with sacrifices to Ceres (the goddess of agriculture) and Tellus Mater (the goddess of the Earth and fertility), as well as other lesser gods and goddesses associated with agriculture. On this date in the year 1940, Z. Budapest (the founder and leader of the main branch of feminist Dianic Wicca) was born in Budapest. Among her many accomplishments, she founded the Susan B. Anthony coven (named after the famous suffragist), hosted a radio show in San Francisco, directed the Women's Spirituality Forum in Oakland, and led a successful public hexing against a mass murderer.

The sun rises two days early in Greenland – Has the Earth changed its tilt?

The sun over Greenland has risen two days early, baffling scientists and sparking fears that Arctic icecaps are melting faster than previously thought.

Experts say the sun should have risen over the Arctic nation's most westerly town, Ilulissat, yesterday, ending a month-and-a-half of winter darkness.

But for the first time in history light began creeping over the horizon at around 1pm on Tuesday - 48 hours ahead of the usual date of 13 January.

The mysterious sunrise has confused scientists, although it is believed the most likely explanation is that it is down to the lower height of melting icecaps allowing the sun's light to penetrate through earlier.

Thomas Posch, of the Institute for Astronomy of the University of Vienna, said that a local change of the horizon was 'by far the most obvious explanation'.

He said as the ice sinks, so to does the horizon, creating the illusion that the sun has risen early.

This theory, based on the gradual decline of Greenland's ice sheet, is backed by recent climate studies.

A report by the World Meteorology Organisation shows that temperatures in Greenland have risen around 3C above average over the last year.

It also reported that December was much warmer than usual with rainfall instead of snow recorded for the first time in Kuujuaq since records began.

It has even been suggested that the sun's early appearance could have an astronomical explanation.

But Wolfgang Lenhardt, director of the department of geophysics at the Central Institute for Meteorology in Vienna, scotched this theory.

He said: 'The constellation of the stars has not changed. If that had happened, there would have been an outcry around the world.'

'The data of the Earth's axis and Earth's rotation are monitored continuously and meticulously and we would know if that had happened.'

A new documentary recounts bizarre climate changes seen by Inuit elders. The elders discuss how the Sun is no longer setting in the same part of the sky. Perplexed, they contacted the U.S. National Aeronautics ...and Space Administration for answers, but experts said this was impossible.

Most startling for the filmmakers, though, was the Inuits' belief that along with pollution and environmental changes, caused mainly by Southerners, the Earth has actually changed its tilt. The filmmakers kept hearing this theory in different communities. Perplexed, they contacted the U.S. National Aeronautics and Space Administration for answers, but experts said this was impossible.

When the filmmakers presented some of their findings at the Copenhagen conference on climate change last year, the media picked up on these views of the Inuit subjects, film co-director Ian Mauro says, and alarm bells started to ring in the scientific community. We had a litany of scientists come back to us, responding after seeing this news, saying, 'This was great to be speaking to indigenous people about their views, but if you continue to perpetuate this fallacy that the Earth had tilted on its axis, [the Inuit] would lose all credibility.' And so there was really this backlash by the scientific community.

Still, the Inuit insist they see changes in the sun's course and the position of the stars in the night sky. These elders, when they were growing up, they were told to go out every morning, before having anything to eat. They were told to go out at the age of 5 every morning to observe the weather, Kunuk says. So when they started talking about the sun and the sunset, I was puzzled too. Everywhere I went, each community, I was getting the same answer: The sun does not settle where it used to. I mean, it [causes] alarm.

The Smart Researcher: How to tell if a website can be trusted

In this day and age, almost all of our research is done online. Whether we are young witches looking for information on the craft, or elder looking for an easier way to get our taxes done, at some point most of us open up a web browser when we need information.

The Internet is a vast network of information that can be very helpful but it can also be very misleading or just downright false. As an academic we are taught how to figure out which websites are good to look at and which ones are better left alone.

The general rule for deciding whether or not a website can be trusted is pretty simple. If a website ends in “.gov” meaning the website is created by a government agency is a website that is safe and can be trusted as accurate and you can quote that information as fact.

If a website ends in “.edu”, meaning an educational institution has created one can assume that the information is trustworthy. You can trust that the information found on a website with this ending is accurate.

If you are searching for information that is unbiased I would caution against using websites that end in “.org” these websites are created by organizations and interest groups and often times (but not always) the information found paints a certain biased picture of the information or organization being presented. With this rule there are some exceptions. Political websites that offer information about many political parties often times do not display a bias.

Websites that end in “.net and .com” are websites that anyone can create. This means that any person intelligent or otherwise can just throw a page together and give it to the world.

This makes pagan research a little difficult then because the former most websites don't usually display what we are looking for. You may be able to find documents from the Salem witch trials, or certain parts of the inquisition on “.edu or .gov” websites

When we are researching pagan recipes or certain methods of practice the latter most websites are the ones that we come across. The remedy to this issue is an easy one. If the website you are using has multiple spelling errors or noticeable errors in grammar its best to avoid that site.

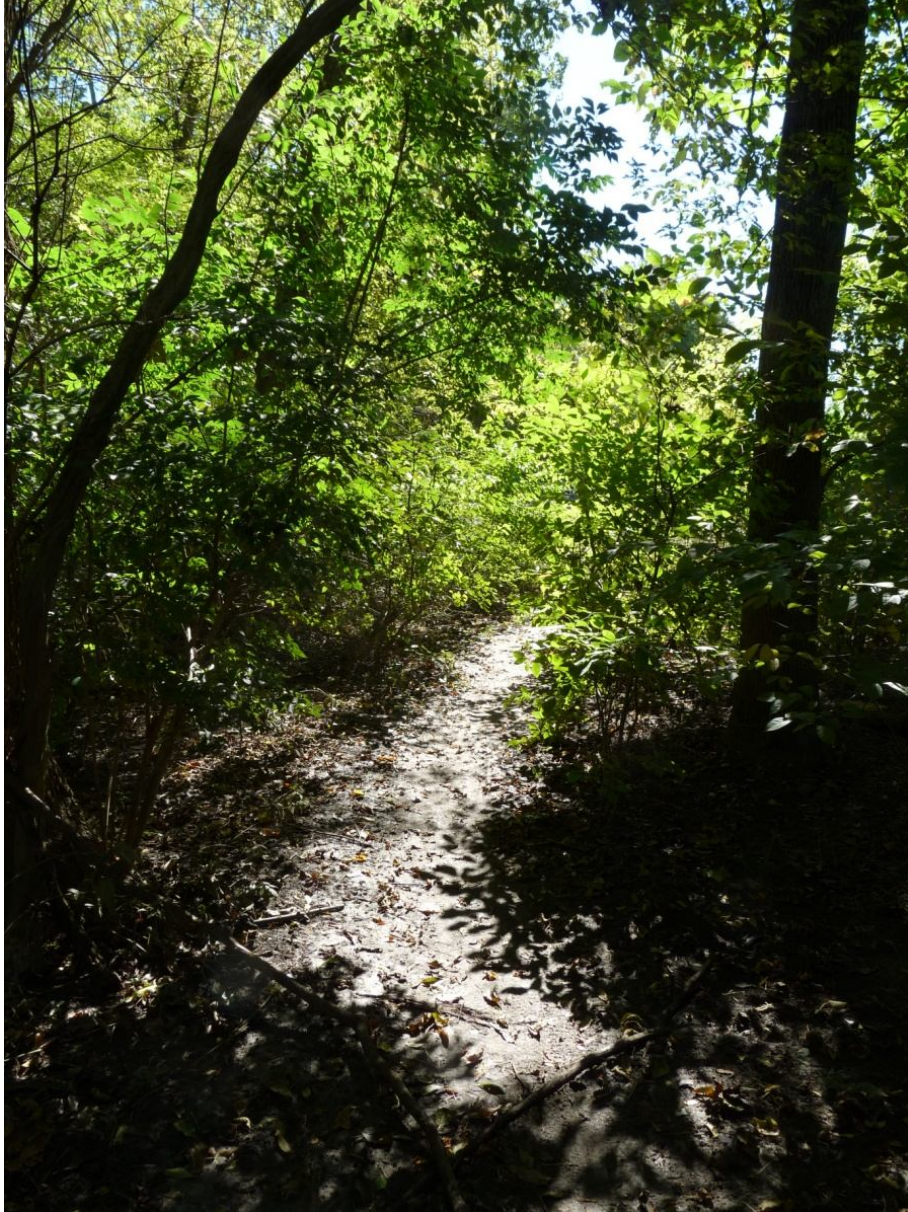
This is because the person who for all intents and purposes may have had something decent to share however, ignoring the red and green squiggly lines of spell-check signals laziness. If a person is too lazy to fix mistakes with just a few clicks of a mouse then what else did they skip out on?

One could advise that when researching pagan methods it is best to look for ideas, and create a personal methodology. Also, because we are in a sense restricted to the latter types of websites, it is a good idea to use the rules of five. That is, check five different sources.

Usually there will be a commonality between a majority of the information. For example if three out of five websites say the same thing well then the majority probably has the correct information.

The aforementioned rules can be used whether you are a young person researching for a school assignment, or an older adult just wanting to make sure that the information you got from the web is reputable.

CANDLE RITUALS

Candle rituals have been around for centuries.

You light the candles, maybe close your eyes while repeating a spell or that which you wish for and visualizing it coming true. Candle burning spells and rituals are very easy to do and to have success with if they are done correctly and you truly believe. The different colors of candles each have their own symbolism.

Here is a table of the colors and their meanings.

White: truth, purity

Red: love, health, sex, strength

Green: money, luck, fertility

Black: discord, evil, negativity, confusion

Brown: neutrality, uncertainty, hesitation

Pink: love, morality, honor

Purple: power, business progress, ambition

Orange: attraction, stimulation

Greenish Yellow: jealousy, anger, discord

Gray: neutrality, stalemate, negativity

Light Blue: tranquillity, patience, health

Dark Blue: depression, changeability

Candle spells can be very easy or complicated. It all depends on how much time you want to put into a ritual. It can be as simple as lighting a green candle and chanting... money, money come to me.

It can also be very long and complicated lasting several days with the repositioning of the candles each day. The choice is always yours.

The first thing you want to do is get the appropriate color candles for your particular desire. Then you need to anoint the candle with oil. Olive oil will do fine. You need to rub the candle with the oil from the middle outward to the ends. As you are doing this you need to be thinking of your desired goal.

Imbolc, Celtic holiday that marks the beginning of spring.

It is ruled by the goddess of spring, known as Brigit or Brigantia in Ireland, and Bride in Scotland. In Irish myth, the god of the earth Dagda, also known as the "good god," had three daughters, who were all named Brigit.

The first Brigit was the goddess of poetry, the second was the goddess of smithcraft, and the third was the goddess of fire and healing. All three are really aspects of one triple goddess who was associated with the Sun and with fire.

On this day Brigit used her flame to rekindle the fire in the earth and assure that plants would have the heat that they need to break through the earth and begin to grow. In ancient times, a woman dressed as Brigit would bless the fires in the households and forges across Ireland.

On this day, Brigit's snake would come out of its mound, and the snake's behavior would determine how long the remaining frost will last. This is the most likely origin of Groundhog Day.

In Christian times, Brigit became a saint associated with the Virgin Mary. Imbolc became the Christian Candlemas, the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is celebrated by lighting candles.

A Brigit's cross is a talisman made of woven reeds that form a cross with a woven square in the center and four equal arms extending out from the center. This design gives the cross a sense of rotation that evokes the wheel of the year. Brigit's cross should be made or bought on this day and used to protect the home throughout the year.

Also on this night one can leave a silk ribbon on the doorstep for Brigit to bless. Later it can be used for healing.

Imbolc Ritual Cake

1 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
3/4 cup water
3/4 cup sugar
1/4 cup vegetable oil
2 tbs. Poppy seeds
1 tbs. grated lemon peel
1 tsp. baking soda
2 tbs. lemon juice
1/2 tsp. salt
powdered sugar

This is all done in one pan, so clean up is a breeze! Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix flour, sugar, poppy seeds, baking soda, and salt with a fork in an ungreased 9"x 9"x2" baking pan. Stir in the remaining ingredients, except the powdered sugar. Bake 35-40 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center of cake comes out clean, and the top is golden brown. Remove from oven and cool. Sprinkle with powdered sugar. Makes 8 servings.

PARENTAL SUPERVISION REQUIRED!

Materials:

Small Tree Branch
Acorn
Thin Brown String or Thread
Yellow, Green, and Gold 1/4" Ribbon
Small Gold/Silver Jingle Bells.

Select a small branch about 1/2" to 3/4" in diameter. Cut top end flat. Approx. 1/2" below top score a groove (parents only) with a sharp knife. Take 1' long piece of string/thread and tie in groove. Take another 1' piece of thread and tie in groove on opposite side of branch. Place acorn at top of branch (flat end) and adhere with some glue. Now pull the string up over the cap and wind once around acorn. Repeat with all 3 other pieces of string. Pull strings back down to the groove in the branch and tie off. This will hold the acorn in place. Decorate the branch by wrapping it with the ribbons, leaving enough length at top for streamers. Tie gold/silver jingle bells to the ends of the ribbons. For smaller children, thread the bells onto the ribbon while wrapping the branch. Tell the children about how the acorn-wand is a symbol of the Lord of the Forest, and how this magical wand helps the sleeping plants and animals wake up and prepare for Spring.

Two Witches, a Modern Craft Fairy-Tale
