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Pagan Calendar January 31 – February 6

January 31. Each year on or around this date, a sacred festival is held in the Katmandu Valley of Nepal in honor of the goddess Sarasvati, an ancient Indian deity who presides over all forms of education. As temples dedicated to her, offerings of food, flowers, and incense are made by faithful Hindus and students who seek her help on their school exams. In the courtyard of the Hanuman Dhoka, an ancient palace where the king is accompanied on this day by Nepalese officials, the annual rites of Spring begin with a traditional gun salute, followed by veneration ceremonies which are performed by the royal priest. In the Hawaiian Islands, a joyous flower-filled festival in honor of an ancient goddess associated with the narcissus flower is celebrated each year on this day; while in China, an annual festival honoring Kuan Yin takes place.

February 1 Candlemas Eve. Brigit, the Celtic Earth-Mother and goddess of fire, wisdom, poetry, and sacred wells, is honored on this day. In Ireland, offering of yellow flowers are made to the goddess at sacred wells dedicated to her. In ancient Greece, the three-day Lesser Eleusinian Mysteries began each year on this day in honor of the goddesses Ceres, Demeter, Persephone, and Proserpine.

February 2. On this day, the Candlemas sabbath is celebrated by Wiccans and Witches throughout the world. Candlemas (which is also known as Imolc, Oimeic, and Lady Day) is a fire festival that celebrates the coming of Spring. New beginnings and spiritual growth are represented by the "sweeping out of the old," symbolized by the sweeping of the circle with a besom (a Witch's broom). This is traditionally done by the High Priestess of the coven, who wears a brilliant crown of thirteen candles on top of her head. In ancient Europe, the Candlemas Sabbath was celebrated with a torch-light procession to purify and fertilize the fields before the seed-planting season, and to honor and give thanks to the various deities and spirits associated with agriculture.

February 3. On this date, an annual ceremony called the Blessing of the Throats takes place to honor the healing powers of Saint Blaise and to magically ward off throat ailments brought on by the winter's cold.

February 4. Throughout Japan the evil demons of winter are exorcised annually on this day with a festival called the Setsu-bun. Beans are placed in every corner of a family's house, and pointed branches and sardine heads are mounted over the doors. Centuries-old purification rites are performed by priests in all temples and shrines. Prayers are written on slips of paper and then cast from bridges into the rivers below.

February 5. On this date in the year 1962, the Great conjunction of the Sun, Moon, Venus, Mars, Mercury, Jupiter, and Saturn occurred in the sign of Aquarius.

On this day, the annual Feast of Ia is celebrated in honor of, and to invoke the power of, the Sacred Maiden of the Pagan mythos.

February 6. Throughout northern Japan, a centuries-old winter snow festival takes place each year around this time of the month. The ancient and beneficial spirits that bring life-sustaining water are honored at special shrines erected in huts resembling Eskimo igloos.

A festival in honor of the love goddess Aphrodite was held each year on this date in ancient Greece.

Legends and Lore for February

February is the second month of the year in the Julian and Gregorian calendars. It is the shortest month and the only month with fewer than 30 days. The month has 29 days in leap years, when the year number is divisible by four (except for years that are divisible by 100 and not by 400 in the Gregorian calendar). In common years the month has 28 days.

In the Southern Hemisphere, February is the seasonal equivalent of August in the Northern Hemisphere.

February starts on the same day of the week as March and November in common years, and on the same day of the week as August in leap years. February ends on the same day of the week as October every year and January in common years only.

February was named after the Latin term *februum*, which means purification, via the purification ritual *Februa* held on February 15 in the old Roman calendar. January and February were the last two months to be added to the Roman calendar, since the Romans originally considered winter a monthless period. They were added by Numa Pompilius about 700 BCE. February remained the last month of the calendar year until the time of the *decemvirs* (c. 450 BCE), when it became the second month.

At certain intervals February was truncated to 23 or 24 days and a 27-day intercalary month, *Intercalaris*, was inserted immediately after February to realign the year with the seasons. Under the reforms that instituted the Julian calendar, *Intercalaris* was abolished, leap years occurred regularly every fourth year (after a few years of confusion), and in leap years February gained a 29th day. Thereafter, it remained the second month of the calendar year, meaning the order that months are displayed (January, February, March, ..., December) within a year-at-a-glance calendar.

Even during the Middle Ages, when the numbered *Anno Domini* year began on March 25 or December 25, February continued to be the second month whenever all twelve months were displayed in order. The Gregorian calendar reforms made slight changes to the system for determining which years were leap years and thus contained a 29-day February.

Historical names for February include the Anglo-Saxon terms *Solmonath* (mud month) and *Kale-monath* (named for cabbage) as well as Charlemagne's designation *Hornung*. In Finnish, the month is called *helmikuu*, meaning "month of the pearl"; when snow melts on tree branches, it forms droplets, and as these freeze again, they are like pearls of ice. In Ukrainian, the month is called *лютий* meaning the month of ice or hard frost."

February Symbols

- The name for the Moon in February is called Hunger Moon, Snow Moon, Chaste Moon, Wolf Moon.
- February Birthstone: Amethyst - meaning Sincerity.
- Deities: Aradia, Brigid, Juno *Februa*, and the Wiccan Goddess in Her aspect as the Maiden.

The Legend of the Snowdrop

The flower called snowdrop appears in February and is a symbol of hope. According to legend, the snowdrop became the symbol of hope when Adam and Eve were expelled from the Garden of Eden. When Eve was about to give up hope that the cold winters would never end, an angel appeared. She transformed some of the snowflakes into snowdrop flowers, proving that the winters do eventually give way to the spring.

The name snowdrop does not mean 'drop' of snow, it means drop as in eardrop - the old word for earring. Snowdrops are also known as known as Candlemas bells. The Latin name for the snow drop is Galanthus, which means "milk flower".

There comes a time when our morals come into question, when we have to stand up for what we feel is right.

On Monday January 24th, 2011 such a time occurred in my life. It's a really interesting story in retrospect. I was coming down off a long day of work, class and workshops and I was on the bus home. This night was no different than any other Monday night, my boyfriend was unable to get me from work so I had to take the "number 8" bus to the train station where I would then take the "metro-rail" the remainder of the way home.

I could tell when the driver pulled up it was going to be a rough ride, standing room only was the name of the game. It was cold out so instead of waiting a half an hour for the next bus, I paid my fair and walked towards the back.

When I got to where I was going to stand my eyes caught a horrific sight. There was a young lady sitting in a seat next to a window. She looked as if she had been crying recently. Next to her was a young man. As the bus moved along Main street I heard a lot of the conversation between the two. He was calling her many beautiful names.

I'm quite sure that one sentence was just a long strand of degrading terms meant for females. Finally the young lady got tired of the insults and degradations and decided to shout "[F-bomb]-you".

With one swift blow, the young man retaliated by punching the woman in the face. Instantaneously her nose began to leak blood like a spigot. The entire bus either witnessed what happened, or were able to draw an accurate inference as to the events that just took place but everyone remained silent.

The young man wasn't satisfied with his handy work thus far so he cocked his arm back to land another blow. Its kind of cliché but the time seemed to slow down as I watched what was unfolding. As the young man lunged forward with the destructive force of his fist, I lost control of my body and grabbed his fist, and threw my arm around his neck placing him in a semi-choke hold.

At once I pulled him out of his chair and onto the floor. I positioned myself in between the man and the bleeding woman who was now sobbing inconsolably. I began to scream at the man, I called him a coward, and a poor excuse for a man, and subhuman. I dared him with all my might to pull his nonsense on me, (something I would later regret) but he just sat there on the bus floor looking at the ground. I rang the bell for the bus and made the young lady get off and call the police.

I stayed on the bus with the young man not allowing him to get off. Fifteen minutes went by and it was now my stop. I rang the bell and got off. What I didn't notice was that the young man got off behind me. I was walking for about three minutes before the young man grabbed me from behind and slammed an ice chunk into my face. I fell to the ground and he began kicking me. He landed two amazing kicks to my ribs and one to my head.

After the young man felt like he had gotten even he stopped. By the grace of the goddess he decided to stop. I stumbled home, blood dripping from my eye and pain in my sides. Immediately upon seeing me, my boyfriend who just got home got me into the car.

I woke up in the emergency room. The triage nurse was holding up a chart asking me how bad I hurt. According to my boyfriend I lost consciousness again. I woke up in a hospital bed clad in a hospital gown. My clothes lay ripped on the floor next to me. Two police officers were in my room waiting for me to come too.

One of them asked me what happened. I told them everything. After I was done telling the story my best friend arrived. She immediately asked what happened. Sparing me the chore of repeating myself the second officer told her everything. I can't help feeling a little offended that the first thing my friend said after hearing the events of the night was "why did you get involved, why didn't you mind your business?"

Her boyfriend chimed in "Next time you won't get involved will you?" I couldn't help but to look at them horrified. Is this what our society is becoming? I remember reading an old news article about a woman who was raped, and beat to death in a busy, street in New York City (I think). The pedestrians on the street watched the progression of events and just stood there and did absolutely nothing.

I guess when thinking about things like this, the question that comes to mind is, what is it that makes the majority of people remain silent while these atrocities happen? How could anyone justify witnessing a murder, one that didn't involve anything but two angry hands, and not stop it? Are these people afraid of being hurt as well?

As I lay in the hospital bed with a fractured jaw, eight stitches in my left eyebrow, and two cracked ribs I contemplated whether or not I would ever come to the aid of another. I decided right then and there that I would never remain silent.

I decided that I was a Wicca and that the flip side of harming none, means not allowing anyone else to be harmed while I had the ability to stop it. I told my friends that if there was any lesson to be learned here it was that I should have waited to put my iPod on, and paid closer attention to my surroundings. Having twelve years of kung Fu, and 2 years of taekwondo knowledge means that I should have been prepared for an angry womanizer to get even with me.

As I spend the rest of the week painfully moving from work to class, and then to my office to counsel my clients I look back at the situation and feel blessed to have been in a position to prevent further harm from coming to another human being. In my personal opinion, and according to my personal code of ethics, remaining silent while violence happens places me at a coequal level with those that commit these acts, and after meditating on the events of last Monday, I decided that my body is a small price to pay for the safety of another.

Spell of the Week

WHITE CANDLE SPELL FOR BLESSING

Get a white candle -- either a plain one (offertory, pillar, or taper) or a figural one in the gender of the person you want to bless. Carve the person's full name on the candle, then dress it with Blessing Oil or Holy Oil. For more power, you may place a name-paper of the person, or a photo, or some personal item of theirs (such as a bit of hair or a snippet of clothing) either under the candle or next to it. One easy way to do this is to place the paper or personal concerns under an overturned saucer and put the candle on top of the saucer. Burn a portion of the candle every day for seven days, pinching it out between burnings.

As you light it each day, say this
[Name], may you be blessed
May all good things come to you
May nothing whatsoever harm you
May your heart be light
May your travels be safe
May your health be good
May your mind be sound
May your friendships sustain you
May you be blessed in every way

If you have a special request for this person (such as that they find a lover, get a good job, come home safely from a war, or whatever), just add it to the list. Some people use a large pillar-type candle and keep it going for longer than seven days. They may make a habit of burning such a candle every day -- or once a week, on Sundays -- for as long as their friend or relative needs help, even doing so for months at a time. If the candle is large and it is to be burned in this way, it should be re-dressed with Blessing Oil or Holy Oil once a week: after the initial dressing, you can drop a tiny bit of oil into the "well" or hole in such a large candle just before lighting it each time.

SPELL TO CHANGE A SITUATION FROM BAD TO GOOD

Burn 7 white candles at 7pm on a Friday evening.
Place another shorter candle into a pot of soil.

After 10 minutes, blow out the white candles in turn and allow the shorter candle to extinguish itself in the soil.

Stargazing Information

As befits a year in which we honor the solar system, four of the five worlds visible to the unaided eye are in view this month. Venus and Mercury adorn the morning sky, Jupiter is in the evening sky, and Saturn lines up between them. Only Mars is missing, lurking in the Sun's brilliant glare. As compensation, one of the fainter planets is also in unusually good view: Uranus lines up quite close to Jupiter, making it easy to locate, although you need binoculars to see it.

This Week's Stargazing Tips

January 31, 2011. The Big Dipper wheels around the North Star like an hour-hand on a giant clock, ticking off the hours of the night. And winter is an especially good time to watch it, because it's in good view pretty much all night long.

February 1, 2011. February, the shortest month of the year, is named for the Roman god of purification. The original Roman calendar consisted of 10 months, beginning with March. January and February were later added to the end of the year.

February 2, 2011. Today is Groundhog Day, which tradition says will tell us whether spring is nigh. Groundhog Day evolved from Candlemas, the "40th day of Christmas." It is a cross-quarter day, which occurs roughly midway between a solstice and an equinox.

February 3, 2011. Mars is hiding in the light. Tomorrow, the little planet will pass behind the Sun as seen from Earth, so it is immersed in the Sun's glare. It will return to view in late spring, but it won't be in good view until summer.

February 4, 2011. Pegasus, the flying horse, stands low in the west as darkness falls and sets by midnight. Look for four moderately bright stars that form the Great Square of Pegasus. The square stands on one point as it drops from view.

February 5, 2011. The Orion Nebula, a cloud of interstellar gas and dust that has given birth to hundreds of stars, is visible as a faint smudge of light in the constellation Orion, which is in the southeast as darkness falls and swings westward during the night.

February 6, 2011. The Moon descends the western sky this evening. A bright companion stands to its left: Jupiter. The giant planet looks like a brilliant cream-colored star, far outshining all the true stars in the night sky.

Imbolc February 2 (spring) Festival of Light Greater Sabbat Northern Hemisphere

Imbolc is one of the cornerstones of the Celtic calendar. Like many Celtic festivals, the Imbolc celebrations centre around the lighting of fires. Fire was perhaps more important for this festival than others as it was also the holy day of Brigid (also known as Bride, Brigit, Brid), the Goddess of fire, healing and fertility. The lighting of fires celebrated the increasing power of the Sun over the coming months. For the Christian calendar, this holiday was reformed and renamed 'Candlemas' when candles are lit to remember the purification of the Virgin Mary.

Imbolc is still a special time for Pagans. As people who are deeply aware of what is going on in the natural world they recognise that there is strength in cold as well as heat, death as well as life. The Horned God reigns over the Autumn and Winter and although the light and

Lammas February 1 (autumn) Greater Sabbat Southern Hemisphere

Pronunciation is as it sounds and is Anglo-Saxon for "loaf-mass".

Other names: Lughnasadh, Cornucopia, The Feast of Bread, Thingtide

The Lord grows old and ethereal, becoming the Elder - as the crops are cut down, so are the days of His life. He is weathered and beginning to weaken. The Goddess is the Mother, heavily pregnant with the infant God to be reborn at Yule. All the growing is over and the harvesting has begun.

Lammas is the traditional time of Harvest, and preparation for the coming winter months. Lammas is awareness of the approach of winter, and thanksgiving for the year's harvest. All crops associated with bread are sacred to this time, in particular barley. The drinks of the season are beer, ale, cider, and all things brewed.

Lammas begins what is called "the chase of Lugh". Lugh is the Celtic Sun God and He grows within the crops, living within the golden fields. This is the time of the first harvests. At this celebration we give thanks to the Earth for its bounty and beauty. It is from these harvests that we eat through the upcoming winter. Honouring the God Lugh, games and sports are played to celebrate strength and good health. This is a time to harvest the dreams planted earlier in the year.

While Lammas can be considered a time of thanksgiving for the bountiful harvest, the overriding theme is one of sacrifice - in that something has to give to make way for something else. The Sun's strength begins to wane and the plants of spring begin to wither and drop their fruits or seeds for our use, as well as to ensure future crops.
