## Pagan Calendar 2 – 8 May

**May 2.** On this date, an annual fertility festival featuring a man wearing the costume of a hobbyhorse, a devilish mask, and a pointed hat is held in England and throughout rural regions across Europe.

Ysahodhara, the consort of the great god Buddha, is honored in India with a sacred festival that takes place on this day each year.

**May 3.** In ancient Rome, an annual women's festival in honor of the earth goddess Bona Dea took place on this date. Sacrifices of sows were made to her in order to promote fertility in women, and the unveiling of sacred objects for only women's eyes to see was included in the celebration of her rites.

**May 4.** Fairy Day. According to Irish folklore, it is on this day that the mischievous fairy folk emerge from their hiding places. To prevent human children from being stolen by the fairies and replaced by grotesque changelings, an offering of tea and bread must be left on the doorstep for the little people. For protection against fairies while travelling (especially through heavily wooded areas or open fields), wear your coat inside out. This is said to cause them such great confusion that they are unable to cause any trouble.

**May 5.** On this date in the year 2000, according to a group called the Lemurian Fellowship, the legendary lost continent of Mu will rise up from the Pacific Ocean. In various parts of Mexico and Central America, centuries-old rain ceremonies are performed every year on this day by shamanic priests and priestesses of the Old Faith. The ancient goddesses who preside over rain and fertility are honored and invoked with prayers and offerings.

**May 6.** On this day in the year 1938, the Long Island Church of Aphrodite was established in West Hempsted, New York, by the Reverend Gleb Botkin, a Russian author and son the court physician to the last Czar of Russia.

**May 7.** On this date (approximately), a festival called the Thargelia was celebrated by the ancient Greeks and Ionians in honor of Apollo, the god of the sun, prophecy, music, medicine, and poetry. The festival was held once a year on the sacred island of Delos, the traditional birthplace of Apollo as well as the goddess Artemis.

**May 8.** In Cornwall, England, the annual Furry Dance is performed in the streets of Helston on this day in honor of the old Celtic Horned God in the guise of Robin Hood. The festival, which features street dancing and a daylong procession throughout the town for good fortune, is one of the oldest surviving Springtime ceremonies in the world.

Theosophists commemorate the death of Madame Helena Petrovna Blavatsky on this day, which they call White Lotus Day.

# Possession: One Wiccan's View

When we think of exorcisms and possession, what comes to mind for a lot of people is the Movie The Exorcist, in which a Catholic priest does battle with Satan for the mind and body of a young girl. In the movie the possessed girl is levitated, burned by holy water, has her neck twisted to the point she should have died, speaks strange languages, shows super human strength and has a strange voice. Is all this possible? Yes, but not exactly the way it is portrayed in the movie. Like most stories, there are grains of truth but for the purposes of Hollywood we like embellishment.

Possession occurs when a hostile or adverse spirit takes control of the body without consent of the person. These adverse forces are often called demons in Christian religion and pop culture and are thought to be the evil minions of Satan. This is an over simplistic view based on culture. There are many spirits of many different categories from ghosts to elementals to angels and even gods. Let us not forget living humans on the astral plane and thought forms. When one of these entities acts in a way the goes against us, this is an adverse force. Not all of them are malicious or dwellers in the abyss, although some are. They may be going against us because, like people, they have an agenda. For example, an elemental may be in the service of a long-dead shaman and be charged with protecting a particular piece of land. Three hundred years later a house gets built on the land and a conflict ensues over the land with the elemental trying to remove the occupants.

But does this necessarily result in possession? Probably not, as elementals tend to be more brutish and less strategic, but they might look for a weakness and exploit that to fulfil their goal. If the occupant, for example, was prone to depression the elemental may look for times to reduce the person's energy even more. It may transfer the energy back when the person is trying to sleep creating worse insomnia. This type of attack is far more common than possession, and is often referred to as oppression. Even though the spirit is not taking control it is still coming into the person's aura.

Conflicts with adverse forces happen over time and build up gradually. They do not just happen one day and all of a sudden your puking pea soup. It starts with a way in. This could be drugs including alcohol, bad karma, mental illness, abuse (whether you are a perpetrator or victim), malnutrition, playing with occult things in an irresponsible manner, or a curse which is cast on you or rebounded back to you. Once the force is attracted to you, it may encourage the behavior making the weakness larger and the connection stronger. This happens though the proverbial whisper in the ear. It is also tied to being in an alpha-state and the suggestions of the adverse force become that more powerful. An alpha-state is the same state a hypnotist induces in people, but the state is easy to induce by listening to music or rhythmic dance. The connection to mysticism would take another article, but yes there is a connection. Once the weakness is expanded to the point where the entity can enter, the aura oppression may occur. Energy manipulation can also occur which often drives the person deeper into depression. An entity may also try to oppress multiple persons to drive a wedge between them.

An extremely rare, but much more serious conflict with adverse forces is possession. There is a connection between a person's soul/spirit and brain/mind. This may be best understood in the context of astral travel, in which it is a disconnect of the soul/spirit and brain/mind, which allows for such travel. Just as a person can disconnect, so too can an adverse or even friendly spirit connect. If it is a willing connection, it is often referred to as channelling. With adverse

spirits, it is possession. When an entity gets into the mind it can create illusions such as heads spinning and walls shifting etc. Things that seem impossible because they just do not work in the world of physics. Levitation may or may not be exhibited.

Some possessed people exhibit superhuman speech or strange voices. This may be caused by the entity will controlling the body as its natural environmental. The entity does not connect into the pain centers and does not feel pain. It may increase adrenaline, and this may account for superhuman strength. It should be noted that channelling could become possession if the channelled entity refuses to leave. If an entity does refuse to leave, an exorcism may be required.

Exorcism is about power and authority. These two things come from confidence and ability. It is a combative arena to be sure and not one to be entered into lightly. It is also a healing situation for the person possessed. There are of course other consideration like is this entity a family member or non malicious entity past human or otherwise. It is important to remember this is in dealing with adverse spirits. In my next article, I will discuss some of the techniques I use and share some experience as sort of case studies to explain the much more peaceful method of exorcism I employ.

Raise a cone of power by chanting and drumming, or racing around the circle.

Then light a Black candle (for solving mysteries, and drawing away the negativeness of the loss), an Orange candle (for luck and precious objects).

Visualize the lost objects in the mirror as already being found.

Place the magnet between the two candles and stroke it towards you as you recite this rhyme:

"By the wavering flame of this black light,

Grant to me of my jewellery a sight.

By the power of this orange flame,

Give me luck to find the same.

In this mirror the jewellery I see

Make the magnet draw them to me."

Substitute the name of the object for the word "jewellery". Say this three times.

Close the circle, but leave the candles burning with the magnet between them until the candles burn down.

# Romania's "Witch Tax": Magic Meets Bureaucracy

On January 1, Romania implemented new tax codes that, among other changes, added the occupation of "witch" to the nation's labor codes. Those charging clients for tarot readings, curses, and blessings must now pay a 16 percent income tax and make contributions to health and pension programs. The ire of the witches, some of whom responded by performing rituals to hex the government, has become fodder for scores of offbeat news stories throughout the west. But there is a deeper story to the witches of Romania. With Romania's entry into the EU, an indigenous folk practice that was once persecuted under communism has come face to face with a global economy. The Romanian "witch tax" is a fascinating study in how the forces of modernity and globalization are shaping an ancient tradition.

## One Person's Psychic, Another Person's "Witch"

Most cultures have figures that sociologist Max Weber categorized as "magicians," individuals believed to have power over supernatural forces but who operate outside of an organized church. While priests lead congregations, magicians have "clients" who pay for private consultations. In the United States, such individuals are typically called "psychics." In Romania they are called *vrajitoare*s, or witches. They are almost exclusively female and many of them are of Roma or "gypsy" heritage. In 2006, it was estimated that there are some 4,000 witches in Romania. Travel guides advise tourists that witchcraft is a normal part of Romanian culture and that in rural areas it is still common for individuals to consult a witch before seeing a doctor. Many witches see themselves as loyal Romanians and conduct rituals to protect their country from natural disasters. In 2004, a ritual was done to curse Swiss referee Urs Meier, whose decision had cost Romania a qualifying match against Denmark for the European Football Championship. The hex was not fatal, but was intended to cost Meier his ability to whistle.

About four in five Romanians are Orthodox Christians. Unlike self-described witches in the United States and Western Europe, Romanian witches do not see their practice as a religious tradition distinct from Christianity. Instead their rituals appear to be syncretic, combining Christian and pre-Christian symbols. The sign of the cross is ubiquitous in witch rituals and some blessings require candles purchased from a church. However, the summer solstice is considered an important day for working magic and some rituals require the sacrifice of a chicken to faeries and other spirits. These elements suggest that witchcraft was in Romania long before the arrival of Christianity.

In 1947, King Michael was forced to abdicate the throne and Romania became a satellite of the Soviet Union. Under communism, witchcraft was officially banned. However, in the 1960s Elena Ceausescu (the wife of dictator Nicolae Ceausescu) is said to have retained a witch known as Mama Omida or "Mother Caterpillar." Mama Omida died in 1967 but is remembered as one of the most famous and powerful witches of Romania. Her daughter, Rodica Gheorge, is now among the most popular and wealthy witches in the country. She also has a blog featuring testimonials for her craft.

A National Center of Witchcraft?

Witches adapted to a free market quickly. Emerging businesses sought their aide, creating a growing clientele for witchcraft. In 1997, there was an attempt to form a "witches' union," in part to counter the claims of dozens of upstart witches that they were descendants of Mama Omida. In 1999, there was even a plan to build a thirty-five room "national center of witchcraft" on the outskirts of Bucharest. However, the witches appear to have become victims of their own success. The idea of taxing witchcraft was first put forward in 2001.

The following year, Romania's television regulator proposed legislation banning witches from advertising on television. The ban was voted into law by parliament, despite a petition signed by the witches. While witches were still free to advertise in newspapers, this came as a blow. An elderly

witch stated, “This makes me feel like I am back in communist times.” Driving this legislation was Romania’s intention to join the European Union. In fact, when the witches were unable to stop the ban by democratic means, they threatened to use their magic to keep Romania from joining NATO or the EU.

While witches enjoy popular support in Romania, many in the government view them as swindlers whose presence makes their country seem superstitious and backwards. In 2003, two witches in northwestern Romania were charged with fraud when their cures failed to work. Police encouraged villagers not to believe the claims of witches. Tensions grew as Romania prepared to enter the EU. British newspapers reported that more witches were learning English and raised concerns that disgruntled witches would flee Romania and set up shop in western EU nations. Andrei Chiliman, mayor of the First District in the capital of Bucharest, called for taxing witches. He also demanded greater resources to prosecute witches with fraud. He remarked, “If money from witchcraft can buy the kind of houses they have, it means witches must owe the State huge amounts of money. All we want to do is recover money and stop the fraud.”

Romania became an EU member in 2007. When public health concerns became an area of “shared competence” with the EU, it became possible for many witches to register as “alternative health care providers.” This greatly vexed Romania’s overworked community of doctors and further aggravated those who saw witches as a national embarrassment.

The last straw was a financial crisis: in 2009, Romania’s economy shrank by 7.1 percent. To pay state wages and pensions, the government negotiated a 20 billion-euro loan with the International Monetary Fund, the European Union, and the World Bank. To close the deficit, new sources of revenue were needed. Last September, Alin Popoviciu and Cristi Dugulescu of the ruling Democratic Liberal Party drafted a law wherein all witches and fortune-tellers would have to produce receipts. More problematic was the law’s specification that witches would be held liable if any predictions they made failed to pass. The senate initially voted down the legislation and Popoviciu accused his fellow legislators of being afraid of hexes. Instead, the witch tax was worked into new labor laws for 2011. Cursing the Government

2011 began in Romania under a volley of curses. A group of witches conducted a ritual to curse the government in which mandrake was thrown into the Danube. The most outspoken opponent of the law has been the witch Brataru Buzea, 63. Buzea has a right to be mistrustful of the government. In 1977, she was herself imprisoned for her craft under Ceausescu. She has announced a particularly deleterious curse. The ritual, for which she will need the help of several fellow witches, apparently involves cat excrement and a dead dog. Her view of Romania’s need for revenue sounded not unlike the Tea Party in America, “They want to take the country out of this crisis using us? They should get us out of the crisis because they brought us into it.”

The United States is also home to a large class of fortune-tellers, who quietly pay their taxes. Why is Romania different? A global recession exasperated the situation in Romania. However, the heart of the matter appears to be not money but respect. The witches are primarily Roma—an ethnic group that long been disenfranchised and persecuted by governments throughout Europe. For witches like Buzea, the tax is simply an attempt to take what little she has by a government that dismisses her cultural traditions as fraud. Conversely, many Romanian legislators feel that the West has written off their country as the land of vampires and superstition. To them, witchcraft is not a popular religious practice or an ancient tradition but a plague of fraud and ignorance. It seems that tensions will diffuse when witches feel respected by their government and Romania feels respected by the West. A move toward resolution can be seen in a younger witch named Michaela Minca who said of the new law, “It means that our magic gifts are recognized and I can open my own practice.” We too can help to ease these tensions by not sniggering every time we are emailed a “news of the weird” article about Romania.

## Stargazing Information

With the constellations of winter on their way out, the stars of spring dominate the sky for most of the night. Leo, the season's signature constellation, stands high in the south by the time the last glow of twilight fades away. Look for the backward question mark that outlines his head and mane, and the small triangle to its left that marks his tail. Virgo follows Leo across the sky. And Boötes, the herdsman, rises in the northeast, marked by yellow-orange Arcturus, one of the brightest stars in the night sky.

### **This Week's Stargazing Tips**

#### **May 2, 2011**

Mercury will put in its best showing for its dawn appearance the next few days. Look low in the east about 40 minutes before sunrise for Venus, the "morning star." Mercury is almost directly below Venus, but only a few percent as bright, so you'll need to look carefully to see it.

#### **May 3, 2011**

The Moon is new at 1:51 a.m. CDT today as it crosses the imaginary line between Earth and the Sun. It is lost from view in the Sun's intense glare but will return to view on Wednesday evening, when it will be in the west as darkness falls.

#### **May 4, 2011**

The modest Eta Aquarid meteor shower is at its best tomorrow night. The Moon won't interfere with the lightshow. The meteors appear to "rain" into the atmosphere from the constellation Aquarius, although they can streak across any region of the sky.

#### **May 5, 2011**

Two features of the bull sandwich the Moon this evening. At nightfall, the eye of Taurus -- the star Aldebaran -- is below the Moon and a bit to its left. Alnath, the tip of one of his horns, is about the same distance above and to the right of the Moon.

#### **May 6, 2011**

Cor Caroli, the brightest star of Canes Venatici, the hunting dogs, is in good view on spring evenings, not far inside the curve of the Big Dipper's handle. Its name means "Heart of Charles," in honor of England's King Charles II.

#### **May 7, 2011**

Orange Betelgeuse stands below the Moon at nightfall. Well to the left of Betelgeuse is Sirius, the Dog Star, which is the brightest star in the night sky. And above Sirius and to th

## Defaulting to Wicca: Issues with Intra-Pagan Dialogue

Over on PAGAN+politics Cara Schulz wrote a great recap of PantheaCon. I will concur that not only is she very nice in person but very funny as well. I was happy to room with her and after meeting her in person have even more respect and love for her, even if she is a conservative! In her post she mentioned something that she and I had discussed while at the convention: Wicca-centric language.

At pan-Pagan events there is a tendency to default to Wiccan language in order to be inclusive. The problem is that it isn't inclusive of other Pagan religions. Speaking in terms of high priestesses, high priests, "The Goddess" and coven structure actively excludes other Pagan traditions. This tendency to use Wicca as a default is because for decades the majority of Pagans practiced some form of religious Witchcraft. That's no longer the case. Heathenry is growing by leaps and bounds, and Mediterranean religions are growing steadily.

It's pretty clear to see why this is an issue for Reconstructionists and other Pagan religions. However, as a Wiccan, I also find this offensive. Right now large numbers of Pagans are using Wiccan language, concepts, practices, structure and cosmology while looking down their nose at Wicca itself.

I had written awhile back about the idea of cultural appropriation of Wicca but I never really delved into it. While perhaps not comparable to the cultural appropriation faced by Native American peoples, it's still a factor in the relationship between Wicca and the greater Pagan community. Not only due to it's pseudo-history, but also it's popularity, a great number of Pagans harbor an active disdain or contempt for Wicca. Part of this dates from the theories Hutton posited in *Triumph of the Moon*, part from the abundance of redundant, and even worthless, books on the religion, and partly due to Wicca having once acted as a gateway or buffer for other Pagan religions.

Yet, as a Wiccan knowing this doesn't stop it from grating on my nerves when someone expounds Wiccan theology, participates in a coven, engages in Wiccan rituals and yet rejects the label of Wicca. We all know people who identify as some form of Pagan other than Wicca, and yet their worldview, practices and worship structure are practically identical to Wicca. This has led to the promulgation of watered-down Wicca, which has fed the contempt and disdain for the religion.

While I have heard Wiccans speak of this in private, there isn't very much public discussion about it. Either Wiccans react by separating themselves from the greater Pagan community or they shrug it off as inevitable in a movement where it is anathema to correct someone else's religious misconceptions.

When Wicca is used as a generic catch-all language for the greater Pagan community not only does it exclude the abundant diversity of the modern Pagan religious movement, but it feeds the idea that Wicca is bland, generic, insubstantial and shallow. We need a more inclusive language when speaking about Paganism. I am making an effort towards that in my own writing, often using "all that which is Divine" instead of speaking of the Goddess or the Gods. If we cannot find a way to develop an intra-Pagan language and dialogue, how can we hope to develop a robust and accurate interfaith dialogue?
