Pagan Calendar October 25 – 31

October 25. Shoemaker's Day is celebrated annually on this date in honor of Saint Crispin, the patron of shoemakers who was beheaded in the third century A.D. According to legend, a new pair of shoes bought on this day will bring good luck and prosperity to their owner.

October 26. Birthday of the Earth. According to the calculations of a seventeenth century Anglican archbishop, the Earth was created on this date in the year 4004 BC. On this date in the year 1440, Giles de Rais (one of the most notorious necromancers in history) was hanged in France as punishment for practicing black magic and making human sacrifices to the Devil, among other crimes.

October 27. Allan Apple Day. In Cornwall, England, an old Pagan method of love divination is traditionally performed each year on this day. A single gentleman or lady who wishes to see his or her future spouse must sleep with an Allan apple under his or her pillow, then get out of bed before the crack of dawn the next day. The person then waits under a tree for the first person of the opposite sex to walk by. According to the legend, the passerby will be the future marriage mate.

October 28. In ancient times, the Phoenician sun-god Baal of the Heavens was honored annually on or around this date. He presided over nature and fertility, and was associated with Winter rain. Sacred sun-symbolizing bonfires were lit in his honor by his worshipers in Syria. Depicted as a warrior with a horned helmet and spear, he was once worshipped as the principal god on Earth for thousands of years.

In ancient Egypt, a series of Autumn ceremonies for the goddess Isis began each year on this date. They lasted for six consecutive days.

October 29. On this date in the year 1939, ceremonial magician and occult author Frater Zarathustra was born in Baltimore, Maryland. Frater founded the Temple of Truth in 1972 and was publisher and editor of the *White Light* (a magazine of ceremonial magic) from 1973 until it ceased publication in 1990.

On this day, the Native American tribe of the Iroquois celebrate their annual Feast of the Dead to honor the souls of departed loved ones.

October 30. Each year on this date, the Angelitos festival is held in Mexico to bless the souls of deceased children and to honor Xipe-Totec (the ancient god of death) and Tonantzin (the Guadalupe goddess of mercy). On this day, write a secret wish on a piece of dried mandrake root. Burn it at the stroke of midnight in a fireproof container and then go outside and cast the ashes to the wind as you say thrice: "Spirits of fire, spirits of air; grant this secret wishing-prayer. Let the ashes of this spell, fix this midnight magic well."

October 31. Halloween (also known as Samhain Eve, Hallowmas, All Hallow's Eve, All Saint's Eve, Festival of the Dead, and the Third Festival of Harvest). Every year on this day, the most important of the eight Witches' Sabbats is celebrated by Wiccans throughout the world with traditional Pagan feasts, bonfires, and rituals to honor the spirits of deceased loved ones. The divinatory arts of scrying and rune-casting are traditionally practiced by Wiccans on this magickal night, as in standing before a mirror and making a secret wish. The last night of October was the ancient Celt's New Year's Eve. It marked the end of the Summer and the beginning of Winter (also known as the dark half of the year). In many parts of the world, special cakes and food are prepared for the dead on this night. In Ireland, a Halloween festival is celebrated annually for the ancient Pagan goddess Tara. This day is sacred to the goddesses Cerridwen, Eurydice, Hecate, Hel, Inanna, Kali, the Morrigan, Nephthys, Oya, Samia, Sedna, Tara, and Vanadis.

New Light on the Chakras

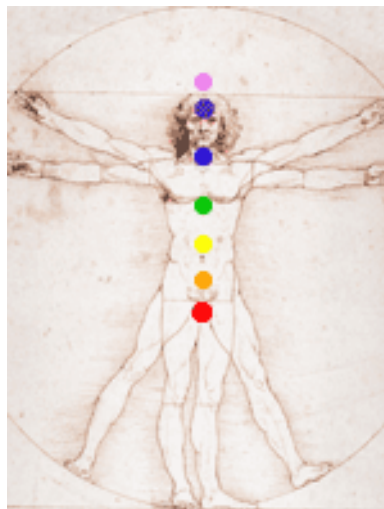
Gateways to Global Consciousness

We live in an invisible sea of consciousness or mind substance, an atmosphere of thoughts and their associated feelings. Each one of us receives mind substance from the environment. We process it through our own consciousness and then transmit it back into the collective unconscious, the atmosphere of the global mind.

In this way, our contribution to world consciousness is automatic. As you think and feel, so you affect the global mind in your own way.

The Seven Traditional Chakras

Traditionally, the seven major chakras are viewed from the front of the body. They appear as doorways of consciousness, located just in front of the physical body. Each chakra is a spinning vortex of etheric energy which channels its own specific frequency band of consciousness to or from the local environment.



From the base of the spine upwards, these are the traditional names of seven major chakras:

1. Root chakra (base of the spine)
2. Sex chakra
3. Solar plexus chakra
4. Heart chakra
5. Throat chakra
6. Third eye chakra (forehead)
7. Crown chakra (above the head)

The root, sex and then the solar plexus chakras are activated as children grow into adulthood. Having reached adulthood, many people go on to activate their heart chakras and some venture into the realm of the throat chakra, especially during meditation.

The functions of the chakras are as follows:

1. Instinctual. The root chakra prepares vitality, or life energy, for the chakras above it. It provides the base frequency of human existence including the instinct for survival.
2. Emotional. The sex chakra powers the basic emotions and passions of human life.
3. Intellectual. The solar plexus chakra is used in the development of intellect or mental ability in a linear direction. Examples of thought expressed as linear intellect include the performing of arithmetic and the operating of machinery.
4. Holistic. The heart chakra is developed as issues of separation are resolved and integrated. Mind, body & spirit are seen as facets of a human being with integrity or wholeness.
5. Creative. The throat chakra's function is creativity. It is capable of inspiring the imagination to create new ideas, inventions and works of art. Most scientific thinking today is still in its early, linear phase. With the addition of imagination, science will enter a phase of great expansion where it will solve many mysteries of the universe. The further development of the throat chakra results in gaining the power of conscious creation, the ability to consciously transform your reality.
6. Spiritual. The third eye chakra is the home frequency of your soul family. While a person's closest soul mates can be usually counted on the fingers of two hands, soul families are much larger. They are extended, related groups of, typically, 2,000 individuals. When you feel a yearning for your true spiritual home, you are remembering your connection to this level of consciousness. In the cycle of reincarnation, it is to this frequency of consciousness that you ultimately ascend in spirit before planning your next physical incarnation.
7. Universal. The crown chakra is your connection to the universe on a cosmic scale. Its complete activation brings the ultimate state of human achievement and enlightenment, that of cosmic consciousness.

You can call the chakras by their physical position, like solar plexus, or by their function, like intellectual. The choice is yours. Their names, by function, are:

1. Instinctual chakra (root)
2. Emotional chakra (sex)
3. Intellectual chakra (solar plexus)
4. Holistic chakra (heart)
5. Creative chakra (throat)
6. Spiritual chakra (third eye)
7. Universal chakra (crown)

Incense Magic

When incense is burned prior to magical workings, fragrant smoke also purifies the altar and the surrounding area of negative, disturbing vibrations. Though such purification isn't usually necessary, it, once again, helps create the appropriate mental state necessary for the successful practice of Magic. When the incense is smouldered in a ritual setting it undergoes a transformation. The vibrations, no longer trapped in their physical form, are released into the environment. Their energies, mixing with those who use them, speed out to effect the changes necessary to the manifestation of the Magickal goal.

You needn't limit incense use to ritual, but avoid burning healing incense just for the smell, or to freshen up your stale house. Burning magically constructed and empowered incenses when they're not needed is a waste of energy. If you wish to burn pleasant-smelling incense, compound a household mixture for this purpose.

Incenses are composed of a variety of leaves, flowers, roots, barks, woods, resins, gums and oils. Semiprecious stones may also be added to incenses to lend their energies to the mixture. Out of the literally hundreds of potential incense ingredients, perhaps 14 are most frequently used. Keep a stock of these herbs on hand if you plan to make several incense. These might include:

Frankincense, Myrrh, Benzoin, Copal, Rose petals, Bay, Cinnamon Pine needles or resin (pitch) Juniper Sandalwood Cedar Thyme Basil Rosemary Be aware that many plants (if not all) smell quite different when being smouldered. Sweet scents turn sour fast.

Two types of incense are used in Magic: the combustible and the non-combustible. The former contains potassium nitrate (saltpetre) to aid in burning, while the latter does not. Therefore combustible incense can be burned in the form of bricks, cones, sticks and other shapes, whereas non combustible incense must be sprinkled onto glowing charcoal blocks to release its fragrance.

Altar Incense

3 parts Frankincense

2 parts Myrrh

1 part Cinnamon

Burn as a general incense on the altar to purify the area

Apparition Incense (caution)

3 parts Wood Aloe

2 parts Coriander

1 part Camphor

1 part Mugwort

1 part Flax

1 part Anise

1 part Cardamom

1 part Chicory

1 part Hemp*

Burn to cause apparitions to appear, if you really want this to happen.

Spell of the Week

VISION QUEST FOR PAST LIVES

1 white candle a glass bowl filled with scented flower petals a bed

At night time, or whenever you have peace and quiet, with no disturbance from others, light the candle, and place it next to the bowl of petals. Lie on the bed, close your eyes, and think back to when you were little, then go further and further, until you slowly remember

how you felt when you were inside your mother's womb. Then slowly go further, and remember

how you flew through the tunnel of light from the heaven, and back again to Earth. See your silver cord (the cord which attached you to your past life's body) re-heal, and you are back into the person's body in the coffin, or even perhaps, into the ashes, which then reunite to form your past life's body again. Slowly, when your unconscious state takes over, you'll remember who you were in your past life - maybe not right away, but you should eventually see yourself, or remember your name or those you loved. Remember, this can take a lot of practice and a lot of patience. Don't do it if you are unwilling to devote at least one hour to it.

A SPELL TO SEE SPIRITS

To see spirits, old European grimoires recommend mixing together aloe, pepper, musk, Vervain, and saffron and burning this in a cemetery. You can adapt this for other locations (like those in which the spirit lived) by adding a bit of sweet grass or tobacco to a specially prepared incense.

Create the incense on the anniversary of the death of the individual you wish to contact. This is then burned at 11 am, in the safety of a magic circle that also holds symbolic items to connect you to the entity. An incantation to encourage the spirit's presence:

"Guardians of the Spirit realm, hear and guide my plea.

When the witching hour rings true, bring my friend (loved one, etc.) _____ to me.

Other souls who hear my call are not welcome in this place.

Only the one known as _____ may enter sacred space."

Repeat the request three times, twenty minutes apart, then wait quietly for indications of a presence. Signs include the scent of flowers or a favored cologne, a cool wind, movement of curtains, and candles going out or twitching erratically.

Once you feel sure the spirit is with you, do not make it tarry overly long.

Take care of your business, say farewell, and thank the guardians for their assistance.

Samhain Rituals and Games

Stones with a personal mark were thrown into the fire. These had to be retrieved from the ashes to ensure luck for the coming year, if your stone was missing or damaged it was considered a sign of forthcoming bad luck.

Also known as 'Nutcrack Night', because it was a popular custom at Samhain to throw nuts on the fire - if a nut burned brightly it meant that the thrower would be alive in twelve months time, and if it flared up brightly it meant marriage within twelve months.

To see if a relationship will last, place two hazelnuts side by side and burn them over a fire. If they stay together as they burn then the couple will last, but if the nuts burst apart the relationship will break up.

Baked cakes were offered up for the souls of the dead. All the family would eat the festival Soul cakes - known as 'barnbrack' cakes in Ireland - which often contained lucky or unlucky tokens : a coin for fortune, a button for remaining unwed, a ring for marriage, a wishbone for your heart's desire, a pea for poverty.

The Ivy Leaf prediction: everyone in the house places a perfect ivy leaf into a cup of water and then leave them undisturbed overnight. In the morning if a leaf is still perfect and has not developed any spotting, this predicts that the person who placed the leaf in the cup will enjoy 12 months health until the following Halloween. If not...

In Scotland the fishermen would wade into the sea at Samhain and pour out a bowl of ale into the waves for the 'Shoney' - a sea serpent-like being, to ensure a good catch for the coming year.

At Balmoral on Halloween night, during Queen Victoria's time a bonfire was lit and an effigy of an old woman called the Shandy Dann was indicted with witchcraft, then thrown onto the fire.

At the Forest of Pendle in North Lancashire, at Samhain a ceremony called the 'Lating the Witches' took place. Locals believed witches gathered here on this auspicious night, so lit candles were carried over the hills between 11 p.m and midnight - lighting the witches or 'lating' them. If a candle stayed lit then the witches' power was broken, but if it went out - blown out by a witch - bad luck may follow.

If any animals were suffering ill health on All Hallows Eve, then the farmer would spit on them to try to ward off any evil spirits that may take them.

On the morning of November 1st a silver coin was thrown through the front door of the house. The coin had to remain where it had fallen in order to bring financial luck.

Halloween and Black Cats as Symbols of Evil and Witchcraft

The black cat as a Halloween symbol can be traced back to the earliest periods of human existence in the Mediterranean and ancient Near East cultures. Cats, however, were not always associated with evil and in some early European cultures black cats were a sign of good luck.

American Halloween symbols, however, are more closely identified with the Pagan origins of harvest festivals and the coming of winter in the British Isles. Anthropology professor Anthony Aveni, for example, writes that, “The Irish...brought over the habit of celebrating Halloween with huge bonfires to scare away evil spirits...in the form of...black cats...”

Cats Associated with European Festivals and Rituals

The restoration of colonial American structures frequently reveals the bones of cats in between the original house walls. This practice was common in many European communities and is mentioned by several historians and anthropologists. Entombing cats protected against evil. According to historian Robert Darnton, cats “have a ritual value” and were thought to have occult power. During the Middle Ages, cats were associated with the devil. Historian Jeffrey Burton Russell recounts a story during the Cathar persecution in southern Europe in which members of the sect were allegedly involved in “obscene rites” which prominently featured a black cat. It was commonly believed during the European witch craze that witches could transform themselves into cats and that at their sabbats, they would engage in sexual relations with Satan, who was himself portrayed as either a black dog or a black tomcat.

The Burning of Cats and the Association with the Harvest

Both Darnton and anthropologist James Frazer provide dozens of examples of cat burnings, usually associated with carnivalesque rituals, although the burning of cats also coincided with harvest times and the warding off of evil. When the bubonic plague struck London in the 14th Century, for example, the inhabitants burned cats in great bonfires, believing that the cats had caused the terrible disease.

In some European communities, the Pagan “corn spirit” was manifested as a cat, prompting farmers to ritualistically torture, kill, and even roast cats at the end of the harvest. Frazer comments that, “The cat, which represented the devil, could never suffer enough.” Harvest festivals always involved cats or similar animals to bridge the unknown and ward off evil.

Cats as the Conduits of Magic and Mystery

One reason cats were associated with witchcraft was that witches, transformed as cats, could affect harmful magic, including the casting of spells. Thus, cats were often maimed to prevent their ability to function.

Cat blood, when mixed with other liquids, was believed to have healing powers. Professor Darnton writes that, “You could make yourself invisible, at least in Brittany, by eating the brain of a newly killed cat, provided it was still hot.”

Superstitions that survive in contemporary society include the prohibition to never let a black cat cross one’s path. To do so invites back luck. Halloween, as celebrated in 21st Century America, depicts the black cat with the witch, reinforcing the notion of magic and evil.

Additionally, cats have, for centuries, been identified with mystery. In the Middle Ages, cats were thought to have smothered babies, while others believed that they caused nightmares by reclining on the stomachs of sleeping people.

Cats are also associated with the ability to see or sense spirits. In the ancient world, cats, as in Egypt, were closely identified with deities. The Roman goddess Diana was believed to have taken on the form of an animal, including a cat.

Thus, the rich history of magic, folklore, and paganism has, over the centuries, left the cat a legacy of mystery, often equated with evil. And that is how Halloween treats the black cat today.

How Hallowe'en Acquired its Scary Traditions

According to legend, Joseph of Arimathea, after Jesus' ascension, went to Glastonbury and founded the first Christian Church which became a monastery. St. Patrick who introduced Christianity to the Celts was one of the first abbots. Archaeological excavations indicate the abbey's ruins are those of Joseph's church.

Seeds of Church's Influence on Hallowe'en Planted

In order to facilitate conversion of the Celts, the Church built places of worship on sites where Pagans held their rituals, adapted Pagan sacred days as Christian holidays, exemplified by the Pagan Lughnasadh, Festival of the First Harvest, becoming the Christian Lammas when priests blessed loaves of bread baked from the first reaped grains and embraced Pagan traditions, such as the Christmas tree as their own. Samhain was targeted to become the day witches, the devil and demons had orgies.

Ghosts of Hallowe'en

Samhain was when the boundary between the living and dead was penetrable, a time to give thanks for bountiful harvests and honor the departed. Pagans didn't fear the dead. The Church taught Pagans that their ghosts were evil demons. This is reflected in the ancient Celtic prayer, "From Ghoulies and Ghosties, Long Leggitie Beasties and Things that Go Bump in the Night, Good Lord Deliver Us!"

Skeletons and Tombstones, Hallowe'en Symbols

One Samhain tradition was killing animals that wouldn't survive the winter so their meat could be preserved. Therefore, tombstones, skeletons, skulls and crossbones symbolized the brevity of earthly life and evoked the fear of death.

Witches and Brooms Become Hallowe'en Symbols

People were becoming disillusioned with the church and its abuses. Church fathers decided a scapegoat was needed and chose to use witches as a personification of evil. On Hallowe'en, it was alleged, witches rode on brooms to a mountain where they met the devil and demons to hold black masses and perform obscene activities. This led to Hallowe'en decorations depicting witches as ugly crones, astride brooms, silhouetted in a full moon, sometimes accompanied by familiars and black cats.

Black Cats of Hallowe'en

The Church originally favoured cats and associated them with female saints. As witches were used as scapegoats, so were cats. Felines, especially black ones, were deemed familiars – minor demons that the devil sent to help witches perform their evil works. Demons shape-shifted into cats, who assumed the role of a witch's pet so they wouldn't be detected. People were also taught the devil created cats and could appear in the guise of a cat and witches could shape shift into cats and vice versa. This is the basis for the association of the hissing black cat with arched back as a Hallowe'en decoration.

Devil as Hallowe'en Costume

The Celts worshiped Cernunnos, a horned god, also called the Green Man, Lord of the Animals, Hunt or Forest, Stag Lord, Horned God of the Hunt and the Horned One or God. Pagans didn't believe in the devil. The Church believed the devil existed, but had no image of him. The Puritans based theirs' on Cernunnos. This is why the devil is depicted as a horned entity and became a Hallowe'en costume.

Jack-O-Lanterns, Hallowe'en Decorations and Costumes

According to Irish legend, Jack was a wicked man. The devil tried to claim his soul, but Jack made a pact with the devil that he wouldn't bother him for ten years. Jack died before then. He went to Heaven, was denied entrance, so he went to hell. The devil denied him entrance because of the agreement and tossed him an ember to light the way for his eternal earth walk. Jack put the coal in a mangel-wurzel, a yellowish colored member of the beet family. People fashioned Jack-O-Lanterns from mangel-wurzels until the Irish came to the New World and discovered the native pumpkins. This was the inspiration for Hallowe'en costumes featuring Jack-O-Lantern headdresses and sheets covering people's bodies.
