


Infinity Tarot

Suit of Witches



This deck is an expansion Suit for the Infinite Tarot. The Suit contains ten Pip cards, four Court cards, and a single Major Arcana card. Use them with your Infinite Tarot deck to augment the deck or replace other cards, to help shape your own unique Infinite Tarot deck.

Ace of Witches

The Witch's pointed hat represents the cone of power, the tetrahedron of transformation, the ability to manifest what the Witch desires through the use of their focused will to affect the fabric of the Multiverse.

Obverse

When the Ace of Witches is drawn it means that the Querent will get their wish in the situation being asked about -consequently it is important that they be very clear in what it is that they want.

Reverse

Reversed the Ace of Witches says that the Querent is in danger of being tripped up by internal contradictions. What they think they want mentally and what they really want emotionally are in conflict. The situation will not end well for the Querent unless they can resolve these internal conflicts and achieve spiritual clarity on what they really want in the situation.

Two of Witches

Alrauna is pouring **TWO** different potions together, one blue, one red. It should be noted that while these two potions run together, they do not blend but remain separate parallel streams. Upon hitting the ground, each potion flows away in a differing direction.

Obverse

The Two of Witches says that the situation being asked about will be influenced by an important relationship with a person or organization that will be of great help to the Querent in the situation but will remain separate from them and ultimately go its own way -it is a relationship between two individuals who remain individual, rather than blending together. The Querent should accept this help while also understanding that it is temporary in nature rather than any sort of long-term partnership.

Reverse

Reversed the Two of Witches says that the Querent must rely upon their own resources in the question being asked about and should not accept help or advice from others, as these will not be reliable. Instead the Querent should trust their own judgment and uphold their own vision in the situation.

Three of Witches

Proelia has **THREE** ravens perched upon her shoulders and is in the act of communicating with them. Traditionally ravens are seen as spiritual messengers, and this card is about messages.

Obverse

The Three of Witches says that Querent should keep your eyes and ears open. Others will tell them all they need to know about the situation. There is no need to ask, just watch and listen and all will be clear

Reverse

Reversed the Three of Witches says that the Querent must make an active effort to discern what is happening in the situation. There are aspects of the situation that the Querent does not see and that will not come to light on their own unless the Querent actively searches them out.



Four of Witches


Mafalda has created a magic circle marked by **FOUR** candles at the cardinal directions. So long as she remains within the circle she has created, she stands in a sacred place between the everyday world of humankind and realm of spirit.

Obverse

The Four of Witches says that the Querent has created a positive environment that is beneficial to their needs and must not allow this to be disrupted. It is important that the Querent preserve that environment and not allow outside forces to penetrate and corrupt it. This is not a time for changes or for new alliances -the Querent should stay where they are and keep their situation as it is.

Reverse

Reversed the Four of Witches says that the situation being asked about is in a state of stagnation due to being over-protected. The situation needs to be reinvigorated by new people or outside ideas.



Five of Witches

Raravis has **FIVE** snakes. She holds four snakes in her hands while a fifth snake is on the ground next to her. The Witch's body resembles a question mark, and the question is whether she sees the snake on the ground. The picture is ambiguous as she is looking in the general direction of the snake, but it is not really clear whether she sees the snake or not. Snakes are transformation and renewal, shedding old situations for new just as snake sheds its old skin to allow a new one to emerge. The Witch is facing such a renewal, but does she know it?

Obverse

The Five of Witches says that the Querent must change and move forward from the present situation but may not realize this need or may not be clear on how to do this. Like the Witch in the picture what they are looking for is right next to them, maybe even in their line of sight, but they are overlooking it and must open their mind enough to see it.

Reverse

Reversed the Five of Witches says that the Querent is very much aware of the need to move on from their present situation and knows how to do so, but is holding back because of an exaggerated sense of responsibility for the situation or simply because habit is easy and change is hard. Here the Querent must understand that there is nothing they can do to improve the situation except move on from it.



Six of Witches


Titania is performing a card reading and has laid out **SIX** cards to divine the future.

Obverse

The Six of Witches tells us that the Querent is forewarned. The Querent already knows what is coming (even if perhaps they doubt it), and they need to trust that knowledge and apply it in the situation to take the action that they already know is needed

Reverse

Reversed the Six of Witches says that the Querent needs to do more research about the situation they are asking about because there are important aspects that they are as yet unaware of. What the Querent already knows about the situation is less important than what they have yet to learn about it. What remains to be learned will not necessarily make the Querent want to withdraw from the situation but will definitely change how the Querent feels about the situation and how they wish to proceed with it.



Seven of Witches


Walburga is brewing a potion in her cauldron while **SEVEN** frogs surround her and watch. There is a famous allegory about a frog in a pot of water that is slowly warming to ultimately boil. Because the change is gradual the frog does not realize the danger of the increasing temperature and is eventually boiled alive, even though it could have easily jumped out of the pot at any point. In this case though, the frogs are definitely not in the pot, and are safely watching the potion boil from a distance.

Obverse

The Seven of Witches says: do not be the frog in the boiling water - jump while you can. The situation being asked about is not going to go well and the Querent should remove themselves from it now at their own convenience rather than wait for the situation to get worse and be forced to exit at a less convenient point or worse be stuck in a situation that could damage them severely.

Reverse

Reversed the Seven of Witches that any doubts or hesitations that the Querent has about the situation they are asking about are unnecessary and that the situation will in fact go very well for them. The Querent should trust the situation at question and go forward with confidence.



Eight of Witches


Albina sits contentedly by the fire surrounded by her **EIGHT** cats. The cats are also quite contented and variously receive affection from the Witch, sleep, or reach for the Moon.

Obverse

The Eight of Witches is a card of contentment and self-care. The Querent is in a good situation and should enjoy it. The Querent should not be distracted by the outside world or consider making any changes at this time because their existing situation is excellent and is conducive to their happiness.

Reverse

Reversed the Eight of Witches says that the Querent is dissatisfied with their current situation and desires more than it offers. The Querent should look outside of their immediate situations for new opportunities that will bring greater happiness, and pursue these.



Nine of Witches

Crispina stands in a doorway or perhaps a columned portico, surrounded by **NINE** spiders. Spiders of course are web weavers -they represent the ability to work with the fabric of the universe and reshape it to our will, weaving reality according to our design. This is the very nature of magic.

Obverse

The Nine of Witches says that the Querent has all of the ability they need to secure the outcome that they desire in the situation that they are asking about and need only use the tools they have make the future they want. These tools may be in the nature of either mundane or magical skills but are all that is needed for a successful outcome.

Reverse

Reversed the Nine of Witches says that Querent has no power to affect the situation they are asking about. If they can, they should avoid or exit the situation altogether. If they cannot avoid the situation then they must accept it and go through it as best they can, knowing that they will have greater freedom in the aftermath.



Ten of Witches

Ilona is being embraced by **TEN** bats and is obviously very happy about it. Bats are, among other things, a symbol and omen of happiness, and very much carry that connotation here.

Obverse

The Ten of Witches says that the Querent is either already in or about to enter into a very happy, very joyful situation. It is a very positive card of good times to come and good times shared with others. This card represents a blessing for whatever situation is being asked about, and whatever the situation being asked about, the Querent can rely upon that situation being very good indeed.

Reverse

Reversed the Ten of Witches says that the Querent is facing a difficult time ahead and that they will need to stay strong as they go through it and keep a wary eye on the actions of others. The Querent may find that expected support is not provided, or even that those they thought were friends and allies are actually working against them.



Princess of Witches

The Princess of Witches represents the Element of Earth, and with it the direction of the North, the time of Night, and the season of Winter. The Princess is associated with the Pentacles, and she will be observed to wear the Sixth Pentacle of the Moon on ribbon around her neck.

Obverse

The Princess of Witches is stable, practical, and steadfast. This card says that the Querent must approach the situation they are asking about in a firm manner: The Querent must be stubborn and stick to their position, and not be swayed by the opinions or actions of others in the situation.

Reverse

Reversed the Princess of Witches says that the Querent is being too stubborn in the situation and needs to adopt a more flexible attitude. The Querent should not insist on having their own way and that if they 'go with the flow' they will be happier with the outcome.

Prince of Witches

The Prince of Witches represents the Element of Air, and with it the direction of the East, the time of Dawn, and the season of Spring. The Prince is associated with the Athame or magical blade, and will be seen to hold a magical blade with both hands.

Obverse

The Prince of Witches is creative, insightful, and quick-witted. This card says that the Querent must approach the situation they are asking about with originality: The Querent must look for new and different ways to handle the situation, discard previous ideas and replace try a new approach

Reverse

Reversed the Prince of Witches says that the Querent should avoid new or untested ideas in the situation being asked about but rather stick with familiar methods. The Querent should allow experience to be their guide and stick to the 'tried and true.'



Queen of Witches

The Queen of Witches represents the Element of Water, and with it the direction of the West, the time of Dusk, and the season of Autumn. The Queen is associated with the chalice which she holds before her.

Obverse

The Queen of Witches is loving, emotional, and sympathetic. This card says that the Querent must approach the situation they are asking about in an empathetic way: The Querent must be kind, give the benefit of a doubt, and handle the situation with compassion

Reverse

Reversed the Queen of Witches tells us that in dealing with whatever situation is being asked about the Querent must not allow themselves to be swayed by emotion. This is a situation in which the Querent's compassion may be used against them, and they need to focus on the practicalities of the situation keeping Head firmly over Heart.



King of Witches

The King of Witches represents the Element of Fire, and with it the direction of the South, the time of Noon, and the season of Summer. The King is associated with the wand or staff and holds a wand in his left hand and staff in his right hand

Obverse

The King of Witches is active, focused, and passionate. This card says that the Querent must approach the situation they are asking about in a dynamic way and one that resonates with their heart: The Querent must go in the direction they feel most passionate about if they are to have a happy outcome and avoid what does not cause them passion

Reverse

Reversed the King of Witches suggests that the Querent must be careful to remain emotionally detached in the situation being asked about. It may be tempting to jump in enthusiastically, but it is necessary to hold back and keep a cool head. Careful though and slow, well-considered movement is required here.



The Moon

Major Arcana

Tryphaena stands under the Full Moon before the sea. At her feet are a wand, athame, and chalice, and she wears a pentacle at her throat - tools long associated with spirituality, magic, and Witchcraft. One hand is raised to the heavens and the other lowered toward the Earth representing the ancient maxim 'As Above, So Below,' the idea that the created is never separate from the creator and that all things are interconnected.

Obverse

The Moon is the card of psychic and magical powers, and also of spiritual devotion. When the Moon appears in a reading the Querent should look for spiritual solutions to the question they are asking about. This could be in the form of meditation to better understand the situation, prayer to seek the aid of Spirit Guides or Patron Deities, magic to influence the situation directly, or a combination of these.

Reverse

The Moon reversed suggests that the Querent should approach the situation at hand in purely practical ways. Mundane as opposed to spiritual action is called for and the Querent address the situation with direct worldly means.
